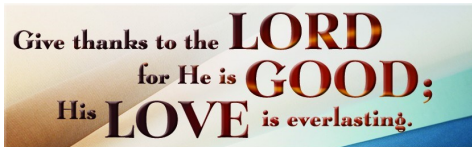

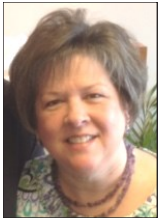

The Paschal Candle

The lit candle is now a symbol of Christ, risen as the light of the world, and come into the midst of the people representing Christ's steadfast presence among us.

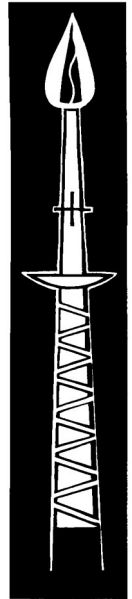
The Paschal Candle is made of pure white wax and is marked with a cross, an Alpha, and an Omega (the first and last letters of the Greek alphabet). The 4 numbers of the year are marked between the arms of the cross. This symbolizes that Christ has, and always will be with humanity, and is with humanity now. Five grains of incense (most often red) are embedded in the candle (sometimes encased in wax "nails") during the Easter Vigil to represent the five wounds of Christ: one in each hand, one in each foot, and the spear thrust into His side.

We continue lighting the paschal candle each Sunday throughout the Easter season. We also light this special candle for baptisms, signifying the Holy Spirit and fire that John the Baptist promised to those baptized in Christ. Just as we light the paschal candle at the beginning of life, so, too we light it at the end of life. Its presence at the head of a casket or beside an urn reminds us again that Christ triumphed over darkness and death and that even in death, there is brilliant life.

St. Anselm, Archbishop of Canterbury, speaking on the same mystery, considered three things in the blessed Candle: the wax, the wick, and the flame. The wax, he says, is the Flesh of our Lord; the wick, which is within, is His Soul; the flame, which burns on top, is His divinity.

Paschal Candle Prayer

Christ yesterday and today,
the Beginning and the End,
the Alpha and Omega.
His are the times and ages:
To Him be glory and dominion
Through all ages of eternity. Amen.

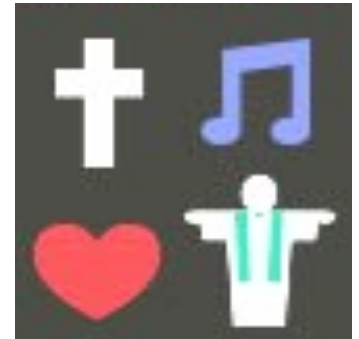

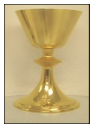

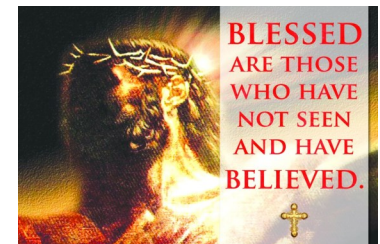
