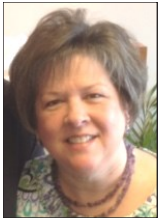

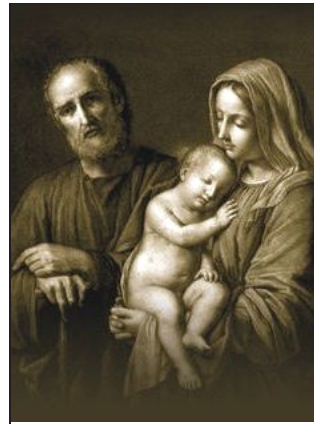
If you are interested in becoming a liturgical minister in the role of EMHC or lector/reader, please contact Maureen Blair or the parish office to register for one of the formation sessions above and plan to join us.

The ministry of EMHC is not a scheduled ministry. Once you have gone through the formation session you have the flexibility to sign up on any given Saturday or Sunday to assist in this ministry.

The ministry of Lectoring/Reading is a scheduled ministry. Once you have gone through the formation session you will indicate which two Mass times you would like to take part in then you will be put into the annual schedule that begins on the First Sunday of Advent. In the meantime your name will be placed on the substitute list which is made available to the roster of Lectors in the event that they cannot make their scheduled Mass.

You will receive Certification from the archdiocese once you have taken part in our Liturgy Day this Fall (Date TBD). Please note that all volunteers must take part in a Protecting God's Children Workshop (3 hours), submit for a background check, and sign a Code of Conduct for Adult Volunteers [these are requirements of this parish in compliance with those of the Archdiocese of Detroit].

Visiting Holy Family Icon hosted by the Knights of Columbus

"The future of the world and of the Church passes through the family," observed St. John Paul II, whom Pope Francis called "the Pope of the Family." Recognizing the vital role of families in the world, the Knights of Columbus has dedicated its 17th Orderwide prayer program to the Holy Family, with the intention of strengthening Catholic families and their prayer lives.

The featured image for this program is an etching of the Holy Family by Giovanni Balestra (1774 - 1842). The original etching, based on a painting by Giovanni Battista Salvi da Sassoferrato (1609 - 1685), is housed in the Pontifical John Paul II Institute for Studies on Marriage and Family in Rome.

The images were blessed by Pope Francis on June 29, 2015, the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul, through the auspices of the Almoner of His Holiness, Archbishop Konrad Krajewski. Under the guidance of the state deputies, these framed images are currently on pilgrimage from council to council throughout each jurisdiction.

Our Knights of Columbus Council #13340 will be hosting the visiting of this icon to St. Jane Frances de Chantal from May 24th to June 6th, 2016. The icon will be placed in the church near the votive candles for part of the time it will be here. At the end of May it will be moved to the Gathering Space. The icon will be available for personal devotion and prayer during this time. The Knights have two prayer events scheduled and invite everyone to take part in; see below for information:

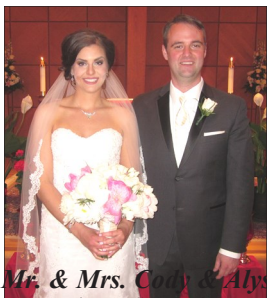
