Reaching Out While Crossing Cultures

In July, 26 people from St. Jane Frances and All Saints Parish (in Detroit) collaborated in a mission opportunity in the city of New York. We spent a week in Spanish Harlem (on upper Manhattan Island) assisting a parish in great need of help cleaning and organizing from years of having things just collect and stacked on top of the collection from previous years. All in all, our modest group FILLED to the brim three, 30 yard dumpsters with materials that we pulled from the church and rectory. (A 30 yard dumpster is approximately 6ft tall x 8ft wide x 22ft long.)

Long days and diligent work were the course for the week, but we were able to enjoy an evening in the local area and Central Park, and we spent the last afternoon in downtown New York City.

Grace, Ss. Cyril & Methodius Slovak, St. Ephrem, and St. Jane Frances) are focusing on the Works of Mercy from Birth to Death. The activities will

include: gathering donations for babies, children, servicemen/women, delivering cookies to the Sterling Heights Police & Fire Departments, gathering supplies for our coffeehouse for the disabled, doing a clothing drive for all ages (at St. Ephrem), having a social hour at Oakmont with Polish dancers, and doing a fall clean up for seniors and at two city owned cemeteries. Needless to say there are many ways you can help and **show mercy**!

In preparation, there are many activities you can be involved in:


