Respect Life

This weekend the church celebrates and reminds us that life is sacred as we celebrate Respect Life Sunday. The Catholic Church teaches and affirms that all life is sacred from the moment of conception to natural death. In this statement the church encourages us to broaden our understanding of respecting life.

Giving blood is a pro-life issue, ending human trafficking is a pro-life issue, treating each other civilly is a pro-life issue, driving within the law is a pro-life issue, being a caregiver or visiting the infirmed is a pro-life issue and, protecting the sacredness of life at any stage is a pro-life issue.

Respecting life is a lifestyle and an attitude that we carry with us daily. It becomes a part of our being and who we are as Catholics. But is not limited to Catholics. Every human person is created in the Divine image and has a responsibility to respect life. As I have said so often, "the mouth will speak what the heart contains".

As we read and hear so often in the book of Genesis, "God created them male and female. In His divine image He made them. God blessed them saying: 'Be fertile and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it.'" Gen.1:27-28.

Our attitude towards others must be that each of us is created in the Divine image and we should see others as being created in that same Divine image. There is so much anger in the world, whether it is road rage, drive by shootings, innocent people being killed for no reason whatsoever, people addicted to drugs or alcohol and the list goes on. Respecting life is a daily activity; much like breathing or eating is important to our physical and spiritual well being.

And at times it can be difficult for us to see the beauty that is around us because the world shows us things that are contrary to the mandate to respect life from the first moment of conception to natural death.

In his message to Catholics taking part in the annual Day of Life in Britain and Ireland on July 28, 2013, Pope Francis says this about the sanctity of human life; "All life has inestimable value even the weakest and most vulnerable, the sick, the old, the unborn and the poor, are masterpieces of God's creation, made in his own image, destined to live forever, and deserving of the utmost reverence and respect."

Have a wonderful week and may you take some time out of your scheduled events and reflect upon the blessing and the beauty which God provides for each of us.

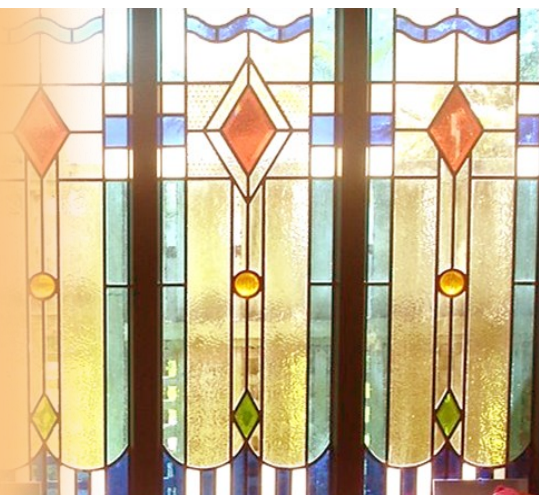
The First Sunday Monthly Memorial Forms for 2024 are included in this week's bulletin.

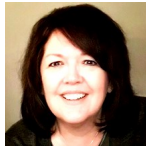

Word of God Sunday

Today we celebrate the Sunday of the Word of God, instituted in 2019 by Pope Francis.

In his letter establishing this celebration, Pope Francis shares, "It is fitting, then, that the life of our people be constantly marked by this decisive relationship with the living word that the Lord never tires of speaking to his Bride, that she may grow in love and faithful witness" (Aperuit illis, 2). Every story told in the Scriptures, even the most challenging, reminds us that God loves his people and will always be faithful to the covenant he has made with us. God sent us his Son, the Word Incarnate, not only to speak these words of faithful love, but also to show us the depths of faithful love by dying on the cross and rising from the dead. Every word of Scripture points to this message of love enacted in the person of Jesus Christ, who is the Word himself (Fr. Brian Meldrum 2020).

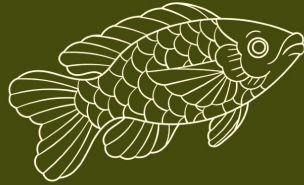

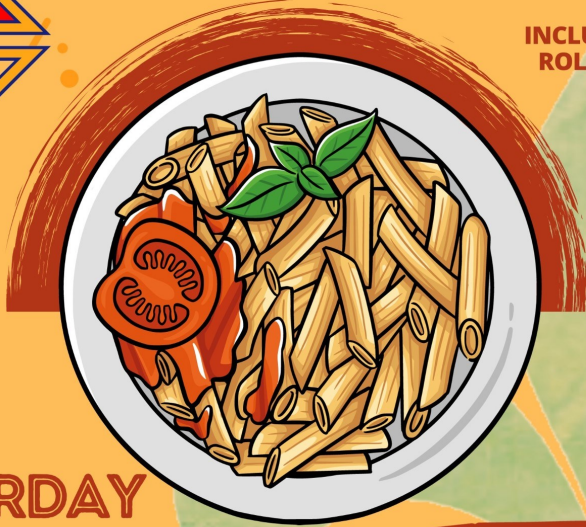
