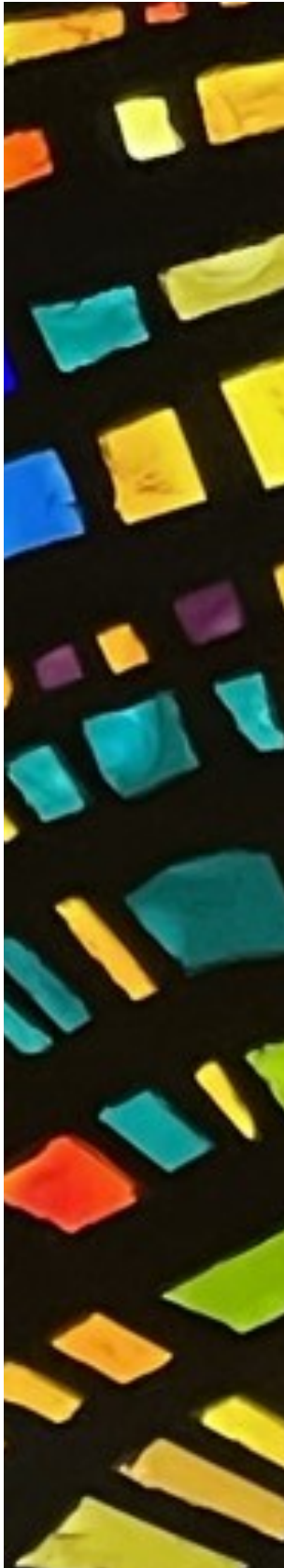

Family of Parishes

On January 12th, the four parishes, namely Our Lady of Czestochowa, SS. Cyril and Methodius,

St. Rene Goupil and St. Jane Frances de Chantal officially become a Family of Parishes. The name that we chose for our grouping of parishes is the Family of the Good Shepherd. Let me state from the outset that nothing will change in the daily operations of our individual parishes.

The priests of our families have had several meetings to define and write a covenant that will aid us in sharing of resources. For example, each Advent and Lent SS. Cyril and Methodius hosts a reconciliation day in which the priests of the Families of Parishes come together for one day to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation with the people of our four parishes. This event allows a great number of people to celebrate the Sacrament and it is less taxing on the priests.

With the declining number of priests, the needs of the people are still being met; people are still being married and buried, the sick and the dying are being anointed, children are still being baptized and Masses are being celebrated at various times throughout the week and weekend.

The Families of Parishes is also a time for the people of God to come forward to offer their gifts and talents in service to the church. There is no such thing as too many volunteers. We are slowly coming out of the pandemic, people are returning to church, we are experiencing the new normal, yet we are in need of new volunteers in every ministry at St. Jane Frances de Chantal. We all have gifts and talents, we all can do our part to “build up the body of Christ.”

I believe that Families of Parishes is the Holy Spirit’s response to this present time in the Church. It is also a time for all of us to “think outside the box” in regards to the Church and her mission. As I mentioned a few weeks ago, the Church has changed in the thirty-six years since I was ordained a priest and in will continue to change.

It is not the same church that I was ordained into in 1986. For example, when I was ordained, there were 1,300 priests serving the Archdiocese of Detroit. In 2023, we have 209 priests in ministry and by the year 2030 that number will drop to 158 priests. That is the reality and we have to deal with the situation as it presents itself to us. However, what has not changed throughout the church’s history is that the Eucharist is the summit and source of who we are, it is the spiritual food that sustains us and strengthens us for the journey.

May you pray for all priests that God will sustain us and strengthen us as we minister to the people of God within the Archdiocese of Detroit. May you also pray asking God to reveal the gifts and talents that you have to share with the greater Church community.

Bon mot: We are impatient and anxious to see the whole picture, but God lets us see things slowly and quietly.

The Church celebrates the feast of the Presentation of the Lord this week on Thursday, February 2nd.

The Presentation of Jesus in the temple shows him to be the firstborn Son who belongs to the Lord. With Simeon and Anna, all Israel awaits its encounter with the Savior—the name given to this event in the Byzantine tradition. Jesus is recognized as the long-expected Messiah, the “light of the nations” and the “glory of Israel,” but also “a sign that is spoken against.” The sword of sorrow predicted for Mary announces Christ’s perfect and unique oblation on the cross that will impart the salvation God has “prepared in the presence of all peoples” (CCC, no. 529).

“We too are called to welcome Jesus who comes to meet us. To encounter him: the God of life is to be encountered every day of our lives; not now and then, but every day. To follow Jesus is not a decision taken once and for all, it is a daily choice.” —Pope Francis, Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, 2019

On Friday, February 3rd, we celebrate the feast day of Saint Blaise.

From the Book of Blessings: Saint Blaise was the bishop of Sebaste in Armenia during the fourth century. Very little is known about his life. According to various accounts he was a physician before becoming a bishop. His acclaim spread throughout the entire Church in the Middle Ages because he was reputed to have miraculously cured a little boy who nearly died because of a fishbone in his throat. From the eighth century he has been invoked on behalf of the sick, especially those afflicted with illnesses of the throat.

Fr. Tony will extend a General Blessing of Throats at all Masses this weekend.

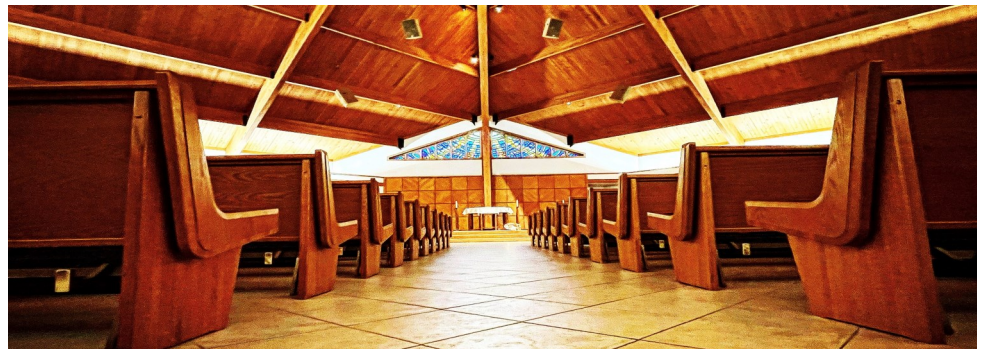

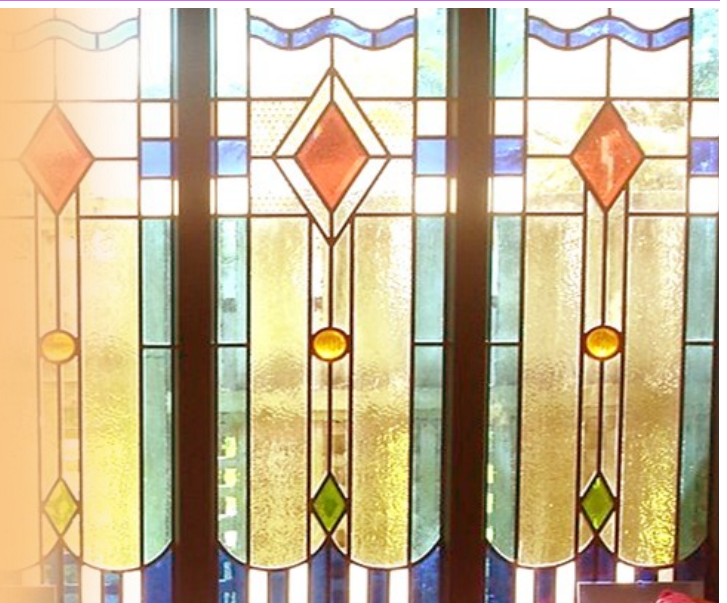
The First Sunday Monthly Memorial Forms for 2023 are now available in the Parish Office.
