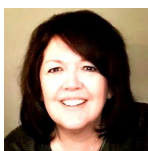

Epiphany of the Lord

The Christmas season is winding down with today's solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord and concluding tomorrow with the feast of the Baptism of the Lord.

Today we celebrate the mystery of God's manifestation to all the ends of the earth. The visitors from the east represent the salvation offered by God to people of all lands, Jew and Gentile, beyond the borders of Israel. The Magi travel from afar, seeking to pay homage to the newborn king of the Jews, offering gifts in honor of Jesus' kingship. Their action to "prostrate themselves" and pay homage to Jesus was not something that was mentioned regarding their visit to King Herod. There must have been a striking contrast between the home of Herod and the stable where Jesus lay and between the gathering of chief priests and scribes surrounding King Herod and the simple carpenter and his wife accompanying Jesus. Yet, despite the humble surroundings and humble parents, the Magi recognized the true king and presented their gifts.

The Magi were changed by their encounter with Jesus. They chose to disobey Herod and not return to him with word of the location of the newborn king. When Matthew writes that the Magi returned by another way, we see that they were enlightened and saw no need to obey Herod's request. They no longer understood things the same way. They changed their plans, their path, and their lives. They recognized a new way, a new king, one who came for all people and all nations.

Looking back at your Advent preparations and Christmas season, how has your encounter with the Lord through these seasons changed you? Do you recognize a need for a new plan, a new path? Where might that new path lead?

REFLECTION

The Magi (Wise Men), remind us that we can use our minds to discover ways of following Jesus. They also demonstrate how important it is to follow Christ at any cost. The Wise Men left their homes and traveled long distances, at great expense, to find and worship Jesus. We should be willing to do whatever is necessary to follow Him, as well.

FAMILY ACTIVITIES

FIND THE STAR: Use or create a small star, then hide it somewhere in the house. Have family members hunt for it.

TWELVE DAYS OF CHRISTMAS CHARADES: Since Epiphany marks the end of the Twelve Days of Christmas, play a game of charades involving the song, acting out one of the lines for family members to guess.

PAPER CROWNS: Cut long paper into crown shapes and decorate to become a wearable “crown” for each family member.

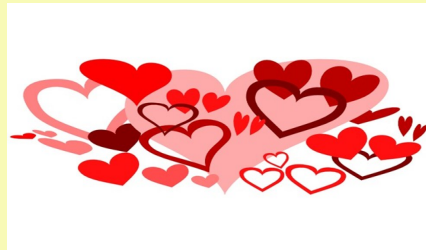

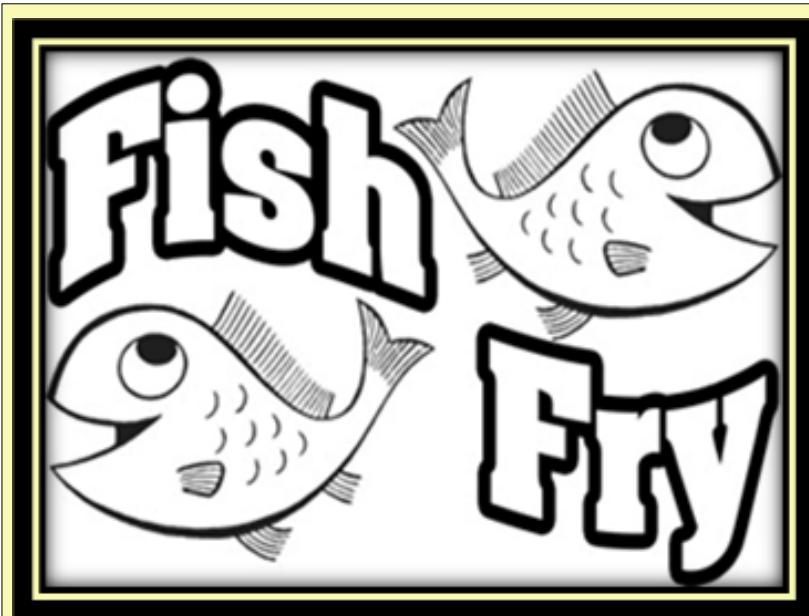

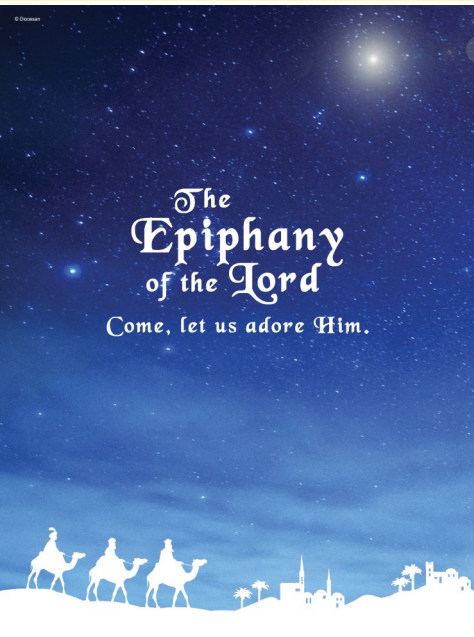
