Policy on Alcohol at Parish Events

One of the first issues that was brought to my attention when it was announced that I was appointed Pastor of St. Jane Frances de Chantal, was alcohol at parish events.

I understand that there has been a policy in place that no alcohol be served or sold at parish events. I plan to honor that policy and enforce it.

I do not believe that alcohol should be used to entice parishioners to attend parish functions. That being said, the world has changed, and the legal system has changed as well.

If someone were to attend a parish function where alcohol was served, and after a few drinks that person leaves the function and was involved in an accident where someone was injured or killed, the families of those involved could come back to the church and sue for damages. Not only could they sue the church, they could sue the organization that sponsored the event, the individuals who are a part of the organization and they could sue the pastor of the parish. The liability and the risk are too great. The parish does not promote or sponsor events that serve alcohol off the parish grounds as well.

One thing that I have shared with my family and friends when I was appointed to St. Jane Frances de Chantal, was the fact that no alcohol was served at any parish events. In the climate of this society, the people of St. Jane Frances de Chantal should be seen as an example of forward thinking on this issue and concern. Alcoholism is an issue and a concern that our society has to address. We will never eradicate this health issue but we do not have to promote it at parish events.

I've been to many parish events in other parishes where people abused alcohol and then they vent their anger and their frustration with the Church towards me. Needless to say, it did not make for a wonderful evening. We all have stories of similar experiences.

May we the people of St. Jane Frances de Chantal be the example that people need to see. I would like to thank all those who were involved in make this policy a reality.

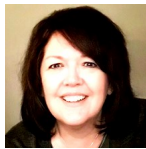

Here at St. Jane Frances we have a wonderful Ministry of Hospitality – our Ushers group. Everyone who enters the Worship Space at weekend Mass encounters an Usher – each person is

greeted as they enter into the Worship Space with a smile and a hymnal. Ushers are also available to help if you need assistance in any way.

Maybe you are being dropped off and need assistance in getting to a seat?

Let us know when you walk in and an Usher will assist you.

Need help with a hearing device? Let an Usher know when you enter the Worship Space and they will get one for you.

Want to take up the Offertory gifts? Feel free to sign up ahead of time in our Offertory gift bearers book at the Welcome Desk or...ask an Usher!

Arrived late and want assistance finding an available seat? Ushers are particularly good at this.

Not feeling well during Mass? Ushers can assist with a wheelchair to help exit the Worship Space or bring water or juice if your blood sugar is low. They can also contact 911 in case of an emergency.

Unable to join the line for reception of Communion? Let an Usher know when you arrive and they will direct a Eucharistic Minister to come to you at the appropriate time.

Our Ushers serve for the express purpose of assisting all in participating in the Mass. They are the embodiment of Jesus' words, "I was a stranger and you welcomed me." Please don't hesitate to ask for help, they are happy to be of assistance! And if you don't need help yourself, but would love to help others, consider becoming a Minister of Hospitality/Usher – this ministry is open to all – women and men.

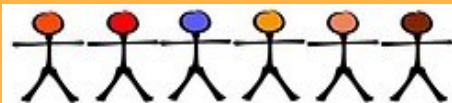
