A Mantra

Last November, when I celebrated thirty-five years as a priest, I was asked by some people to give a reflection on the past thirty-five years. I can say without a doubt that they have been wonderful years and I have experienced the church throughout my travels to various countries I have visited. The Catholic Church is universal, alive, and well.

I was also asked to reflect on a personal level in regards to priesthood. In the past thirty-five years of preaching on the Word of God, there is a common theme that threads itself throughout my preaching as well as my prayer and spiritual life. I have dubbed it my mantra of sorts and those who have heard me preach will agree. It is, Be Fed, Be Sent. The Word of God and the Eucharist are the summit and source of who we are as Catholics. During the Vatican II Council, the church fathers made that the central theme of the documents of Vatican II.

The Word of God that we hear proclaimed every time we come to liturgy and the Eucharist we are partakers of, feeds us to live out our Catholic Faith throughout the week. And being sent encourages us to share the Word of God with the people we encounter in the places we visit, in our place of work, and those we meet unexpectedly throughout our journey.

As we have all experienced sometime, it can be a challenge to be Christ like in today's society. Yet it is God who gives us the strength to carry out His mission in the world.

As I have said from time to time; it is God's work that we are about and not our own. In my reflection on my ministry these past thirty-five years, I have to remind myself that it is God who calls me each day to undertake the ministry of living out His word in my life.

Throughout the history of the Catholic Church, Popes have spoken to the importance of the Eucharist and Sacred Scripture in the life of the faithful. Pope Leo XIII in his letter titled *Mirae Caritatis* (1902), says this with regards to the Eucharist: "By this Sacrament faith is fed, in it the mind finds nourishment, the objections of the rationalists is brought to naught, and abundant light is thrown on the supernatural order."

Pope Clement XI in his letter *Unigenitus* (1713) states the importance of Sacred Scripture in the life of the faithful when he says: "It is useful and necessary at all times, in all places, and for every person, to study and to know the spirit, the piety, and the mysteries of Sacred Scripture."

Let us live our lives knowing that the Lord feeds us and sends us forth to proclaim His word to the world.

Meet Madeliene Krick

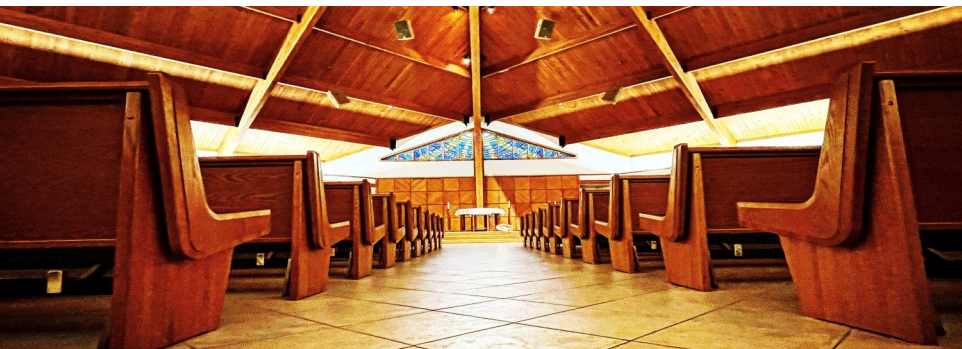

I am coming to St. Jane Frances from a few other churches in the metro Detroit area. Most recently, I have been at Mother of God Chaldean Church in Southfield, serving as a choir accompanist, and at the National Shrine of the Little Flower Basilica in Royal Oak, where I was interim Director of Music in 2021. I grew up at Shrine, and I started in their children's choir at 7 years old. While I was there, I learned to love so many different kinds of worship music. We have a lovely group of dedicated members and we would be glad to welcome some new voices to our ensemble. When I am not at St. Jane Frances accompanying our services or rehearsing, I am usually on the Oakland University campus, where I am currently finishing a degree in Voice Performance. I love opera and jazz and I have a big dog named Albus who might come to visit sometimes. I am so excited to get to know this parish and to serve it to the best of my ability. Thank you to everyone who has already extended such a warm welcome to me! I am grateful for the opportunity to become part of the community.

On November 2, 2022, the Feast of All Souls, Archbishop Vigneron released a letter titled *A Call to Prayer: A Pastoral Note on Praying for the Souls in Purgatory*. The letter can be read in its entirety at aod.org/holysouls.

“Every soul should have the opportunity to enter heaven. This is the basic message of the Gospel (Mt 28:17-20; Col 3:1-3). The mission and intention are to pray for the souls in purgatory as a vocation and mission of mercy to relieve and gain release for the suffering souls in Purgatory who can no longer help themselves.

In *A Call to Prayer: A Pastoral Note on Praying for the Souls in Purgatory*, Archbishop Vigneron calls for the entire Archdiocese to pray for the souls in purgatory by forming chapters of a Confraternity for Holy Souls in each Family of Parishes. It is through the work and ministry of these chapters that we hope that our local Church in southeast Michigan will grow into an active community of intercessors praying regularly for the souls in purgatory.

The intention of the *Confraternity for Holy Souls* is to help the faithful:

- Know and understand how to pray for the souls in purgatory.
- Know and understand the Church’s teaching on indulgences.
- The Four Last Things (Death, Judgment, Heaven, and Hell).
- Offer guidance in offering prayers, Masses, the exercise of indulgences, and the understanding of the doctrine of suffering associated with the souls in purgatory an incomplete suffering.
- Establish monthly Holy Hours for the Holy Souls” (aod.org/holysouls).

Archbishop Vigneron states that, “Through the formation of Confraternity chapters in Families of Parishes throughout the Archdiocese of Detroit, I hope that the Church of Detroit will develop an active community of intercessors praying regularly for the souls in purgatory.” As such, we will form a chapter here at St. Jane Frances. **If you are interested in learning more or are ready to answer a call to this ministry, please contact Laurie Hall at lhall@sjfparish.org or 586-977-8080 ext. 104.**
