### Ordination Anniversary

Two weeks ago we heard the words from the book of Hebrews that are familiar to every priest, spoken at every ordination. You are my son: this day I have begotten you;

just as he says in another place: You are a priest forever in the order of Melchizedek. Hebrews 5:5-6.

On November 22<sup>nd</sup> of this year I will celebrate my 36<sup>th</sup> anniversary as a priest. As I reflect upon the past thirty-six years, I recall with great fondness the sixteen classmates who were ordained that year. The four years in the seminary as we prepared for our life in service to the Church and to the people of God were great years, very memorable years.

Of the sixteen that were ordained in 1986 four have died, four have left the priesthood, three have retired, and five are still pastors of parishes throughout the province of Michigan. Until its closing in 1987, St. John's Provincial Seminary was a major seminary in the state of Michigan. Anyone wishing to study for the priesthood within the province of Michigan attended St. John's for its theological studies. So I was able to meet people from all over the State of Michigan.

How quickly thirty-six years has gone. It seems like only yesterday that I was unpacking my bags at my first assignment, St. Linus in Dearborn Heights. A lot of water has flowed under the bridge since those first days after ordination.

I am grateful to God for calling me to the priesthood, for the many people I have met along the way and the many experiences I have had. I would be remiss if I did not recall the challenges that graced my life and my ministry. They serve as a reminder to me that all things are possible with God if we just stay out of His way. As I have said so often, this is God's work we are about, and not our own. Indeed.

The Church has changed in the past thirty-six years; the Church I was ordained to is not the Church of today. The Church is ever changing just as we are. However, two things will always remain the same, that God is always faithful to His people and the Eucharist is the summit and source of who we are as Catholics.

I ask that you pray for me as I will pray for you. Together, we are on a journey of faith. And together we will build up the Body of Christ. Have a great week.

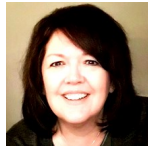
