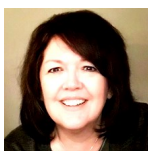

As we celebrate Mass this week on the fourth Sunday of Advent, we gain an awareness that our time of preparation and waiting is almost over. As usual, it finds most of us wondering where the

time went! It seems just last week that we entered into this season of preparation for both the coming of Jesus into the world today and the second coming of Jesus in the future. The last week of Advent provides time to complete our preparations as well as to reflect on the graces granted to us as children of God.

In today's second reading, St. Paul tells the Christians in Rome that they (and we) have received the "grace of apostleship." As apostles of Christ, we are to bring the Good News to all peoples. Often, we encounter people who are certain that there is no Good News, that the secular world is all there is. The constant news cycle can leave people overwhelmed as it seems to be filled with reports of violence and a general feeling of chaos. We must counter this hopelessness with the hope that comes from our gift of faith, from knowing that the things of this world are exactly that, of this world. We must move out of our comfort zones to bring the Good News to all, to avoid complacency, and to use the graces given to us. Whether it is Advent, Christmas time, or Ordinary time, we are called to bring Jesus to others through our everyday interactions, with kindness, hopefulness, and a spirit of joy.

Let us reflect today on our call to apostleship, to be holy in service to God and God's people. As the secular world prepares for presents under the tree, we celebrate God's continued presence among us. How might we actively show our joy in Jesus? How might we actively take on the role of apostle in the world today?

Today is the fourth Sunday in Advent. Advent is a special time in the church year. It is a time when we prepare ourselves for the coming of Jesus. We prepare ourselves for the coming of Jesus born as a baby in Bethlehem. We prepare ourselves for the coming of Jesus among us here and now. We prepare ourselves for the coming of Jesus in glory at the end of time. God loves us so much that God is willing to do anything to show it, including sending God's only Son, Jesus, to earth. In Jesus, God shows love in the form of a baby born to Mary. Mary was a simple girl, not rich, not a celebrity, not an expert, but God chose her. Mary loved God and was faithful to God. Jesus would grow up and show us what God's love looks like in human form. God's love is for everyone – no one is left out or excluded.

Discuss as a family:

- What is God's love like? How big is God's love?
- When do you feel love?
- How do we show love to others?

ACTIVITY: Together, as a family, make heart shaped cookies and decorate them with frosting and your favorite toppings, including sprinkles. Enjoy eating them together and share them with all your guests during the holiday season.

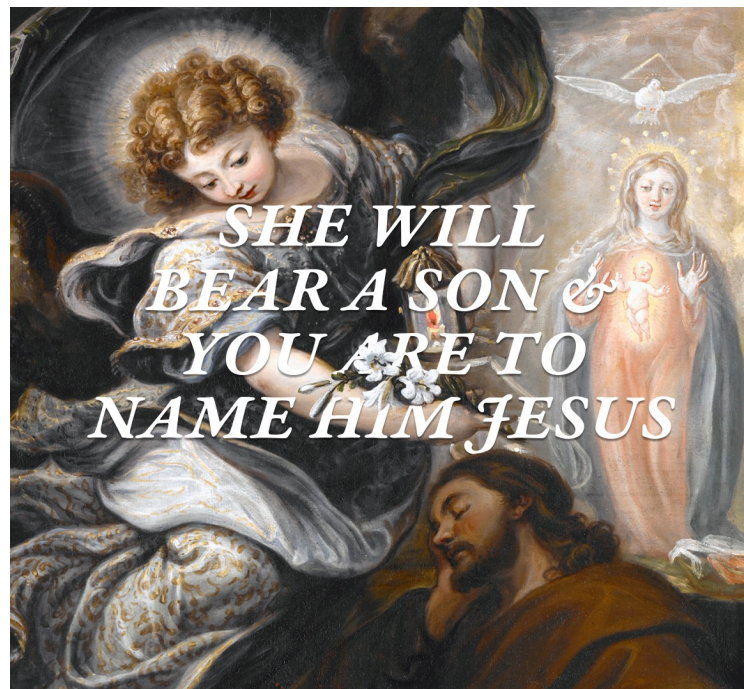
