# **A New Season Approaches**

Many people have asked me about a quote that I used in a recent Sunday

homily. You can find the quote at that end of this article as the bon mot for the week. It is a wonderful quote to inspire us to take the risk, and to live life to its fullest.

Soon we will begin a new season in the church's liturgical year. On February  $22^{nd}$ , we will begin the season of Lent, a season of self denial, discipline and preparation for the great feast of Easter. The theme of our Lenten journey at St. Jane Frances de Chantal is from the prophet **Joel, "return to the Lord, your God.**"

In a few days you will receive a tri-fold that will provide you with some of the events that will be taking place here at the parish. These events are a means to prepare us for our Lenten pilgrimage of forty days. I personally prefer the season of Lent to the season of Advent. There is less preparation during this time, the days are getting longer, spring is just around the corner, and with Easter comes new life.

I have always told people that life is what you make it. You can either see the glass half full or half empty, the choice is ours and ours alone. I am reminded of the Easter Vigil, as we sit in a darkened church the first words we hear as the Vigil begins is, Christ our Light. And our response is, Thanks be to God. In our preparation of the great feast of Easter may we be the light of Christ in our own part of the world, in our families, workplace, our community, and in our lives. We are the light that can shatter the darkness; we are the light that can lead other to a deeper relationship with the Lord.

As we begin this Lenten journey may we Live Lent, Live Life; the choice is ours. Have a great week. See you at the Fish Frys!




