A New Season Approaches

Many people have asked me about a quote that I used in a recent Sunday homily. You can find the quote at that end of this article as the bon mot for the week. It is a wonderful quote to inspire us to take the risk, and to live life to its fullest.

Soon we will begin a new season in the church's liturgical year. On February 22nd, we will begin the season of Lent, a season of self denial, discipline and preparation for the great feast of Easter. The theme of our Lenten journey at St. Jane Frances de Chantal is from the prophet **Joel, "return to the Lord, your God."**

In a few days you will receive a tri-fold that will provide you with some of the events that will be taking place here at the parish. These events are a means to prepare us for our Lenten pilgrimage of forty days. I personally prefer the season of Lent to the season of Advent. There is less preparation during this time, the days are getting longer, spring is just around the corner, and with Easter comes new life.

I have always told people that life is what you make it. You can either see the glass half full or half empty, the choice is ours and ours alone. As we prepare for the season of Lent may we not see it as a season to "get through" but rather may it be a time of self discovery, a time of prayer, and a time of seeing the hope that is ever present in the world. I know that at times, it can be difficult to see the hope that is present in the world, but it is indeed present. Looking at the world with the eyes of faith, the hope shines through the darkness of the world.

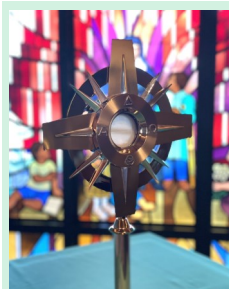

Visitor Entrance and Bag Policies

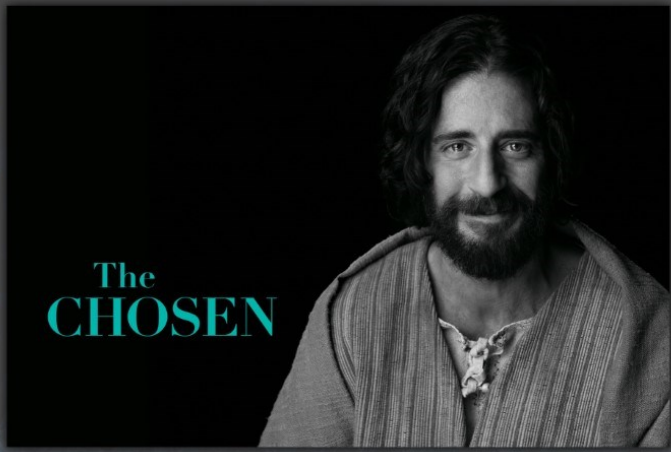
- No bags larger than 11” x 10” x 3” are allowed in the museum.
