Peace be with you!!!

It goes without saying that we celebrated Easter differently this year. It was wonderful to see so many people come to celebrate the great feast of Easter, yet Easter came and as in years past we celebrated the Resurrection of the Lord in a way that was meaningful for us. He has been raised. Indeed, He has. He is not in the tomb. In this Easter season, these fifty days between Easter and Pentecost, the church invites us to reflect deeper upon our relationship with Christ.

The Gospel for the second Sunday after Easter was from John 20:19-31. It is the Gospel when Jesus appears to the disciples who have locked themselves in the upper room. Despite the locked door, Jesus appears to them and says, "Peace be with you". This piece of Scripture is one of my favorites and I reflect upon it often. You may recall the homily that I preached three weeks ago in which I said if I could give this Gospel a title it would be: What Jesus could have said and didn't.

If we reflect upon all that had happened from Holy Thursday to Easter, the reaction of the disciples when they find themselves in difficult and challenging situations, their first reaction is to run from the situation and distance themselves from Jesus. Yet, in the Gospel, Jesus knowing all that had happened says to his disciples, "Peace be with you". And a calming presence comes over the disciples.

This was a difficult and long journey for all of us. It has changed our lives and has become the "new normal". When we find ourselves becoming frustrated and unable to see any hope in the present situation may we take comfort in the words of Jesus, Peace be with you and know that He is with you until the end of time. I would invite you to read John 20:19-31 and meditate upon it as we journey through this Easter season.

I recently read an article about how the pandemic has affected how we look at life and all that life has to offer us. The author of the article explores two gifts that have been stifled by the pandemic, namely our ability to see our experiences through the lens of wonderment and awe. This Easter season provides for us the opportunity to see with the eyes of faith the many ways which God reveals himself to us. God has blessed us, let us not take that for granted.

Like the disciples, we too will receive the gifts of the Spirit. The challenge for us as we prepare to celebrate the Feast of Pentecost, will be do we avail ourselves to these gifts or do we allow them to remain dormant. The choice is ours.

Bon mot: Faith is to believe, on the word of God, what we do not see, and its reward is to see and enjoy what we believe.

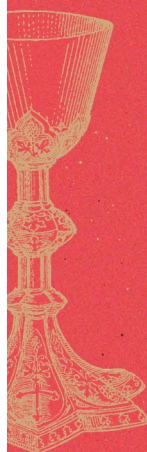

Part 2



Eucharist is the true body and blood of Christ for the nourishment of the soul.

5. **Jesus' Love:** Jesus loves us so much that he wants to be close to us in this special way. When we receive Communion, we are receiving Jesus himself into our hearts.

6. **Encourage Questions:** It's okay to have questions about this belief and you are encouraged to ask them. If family members or parents can't answer your questions, ask a leader at the church or even the priest or deacon.

7. **Practical Application:** How can you respond to this belief? Prepare your hearts to receive Jesus. Approach the Eucharist with reverence and love. Reverence is regarding something with respect or a profound emotion inspired by God.

8. **Reinforcement:** Reinforce the concept of the Real Presence through stories from the Bible and the words of the Last Supper: "This is my body," "This is my blood," "Do this in remembrance of me." You can also reinforce the concept through participation in the Mass, receiving Communion and through other Catholic rituals.
