The feasts that began this stretch of Ordinary Time have passed and we are

now fully into the long period of Ordinary Time that continues until Advent. Ordinary Time is not just the absence of a major season any more than our lives are ordinary on days that are not holidays. The extraordinary happens at any time, in any season. For the Church, Ordinary Time forms the foundation of the liturgical year; it comprises almost two-thirds of the calendar. As we settle into the longest season of the year, let's remember the spirit of Easter and continue to move forward with joy and hope!

Our newly initiated members are beginning to live out the sacraments they received at Easter this year – I ask that you please continue to pray for Deirdre, Nadia, and Selah on this leg of their journey of faith! 


Classics Shine At St. Jane Frances


