## Ordinary Time

The feasts that began this stretch of Ordinary Time have passed and we are now fully into the long period of Ordinary Time that continues until Advent. Ordinary Time is not just the absence of a major season any more than our lives are ordinary on days that are not holidays. The extraordinary happens at any time, in any season. For the Church, Ordinary Time forms the foundation of the liturgical year; it comprises almost two-thirds of the calendar. As we settle into the longest season of the year, let's remember the spirit of Easter and continue to move forward with joy and hope!

### RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Our newly initiated members are beginning to live out the sacraments they received at Easter this year – I ask that you please continue to pray for Deirdre, Nadia, and Selah on this leg of their journey of faith! The Holy Spirit continues to work within the hearts of all people, continually drawing us into closer relationship with Jesus. If you are someone or know someone who is feeling called to the Catholic faith, the process of conversion or initiation can begin at any time. For those of us who are already members of the faith, now is the time to begin praying in earnest for the Holy Spirit to direct those looking for a faith community to St. Jane Frances.

I am asking for the prayers of the entire community to ask God to send us seekers – people looking to form a relationship with Jesus through the Sacraments of the Catholic Church. We can begin the process at any time to prepare people for reception of the Sacraments at Easter Vigil in 2024. Once we have seekers, we will need sponsors and those who are willing to share their faith with a small group. I ask you to please include prayers for a Spirit-filled group of people to come forward to form the RCIA team, but, most importantly, for our evangelization efforts to be increased so that we bring in those seeking initiation.

Join us each Tuesday at 6:00pm to pray a Novena to Our Mother of Perpetual Help and to pray the Rosary in the main Worship Space. All are welcome and encouraged to join in.

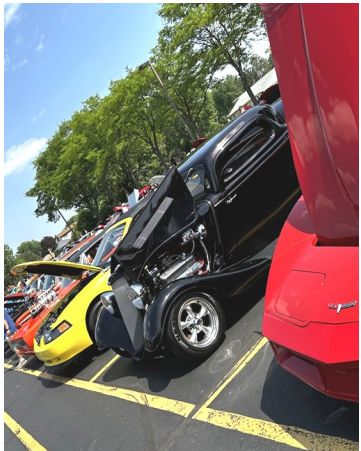




## Classics Shine At St. Jane Frances

I became a father in my early 20's and by the age of 26, I already had four children. More children came later, and in the midst of it all, I received

a call to work for The Church. I accepted that call and 38 years later, I have never lost the fire that fueled me way back in the beginning. I love what I do and look forward to each catechetical lesson, each youth ministry session, every retreat, sacrament and outing to all corners of the nation and world. I now boast 10 grandchildren as I embark on another World Youth Day, my seventh. I have been fortunate to be chosen as an animator, an emcee, and guest speaker in many countries including Canada, Germany, Australia, Spain, and Poland. I have earned the reputation as "Americano Loco" (thus the growing of long hair this year) and my group has always been known as the "Crazy Americanos." In Germany at a past World Youth Day, the Cardinal of Koln was at an event and asked the photographers to pause their picture taking of him. He motioned for the "Crazy Americanos" to join him on the altar in our infamous red, white, and blue tie-dye shirts and the picture taking resumed. He announced that the church we were staying at in Oberhausen, chosen to close after World Youth Day, would remain open because of the incredible amount of service work we had done in the community that week and the necessity for it to continue. Everyone applauded and we were rock stars, as in every other World Youth Day venture where we ignite the faith of the world with our Deetroit attitude and infectious spirit.

As a father, it has been an honor and a blessing to raise my children and watch my grandchildren grow, instilling faith into their everyday lives. As a Director of Education and Youth Minister, it is an honor and a blessing to ignite the faith of God's children in the churches I work at and all over the world at events like World Youth Day. Please pray for us and with us as we venture to Portugal to spend 4 days with the Pope this summer and 18 days on our pilgrimage, including a stop at Fatima. Happy Father's Day to all the dads out there. And to all others who continue to influence and nurture our youth, let us keep the faith alive in our next generation of young disciples!

**Applications are due by Sunday, August 6, 2023.**

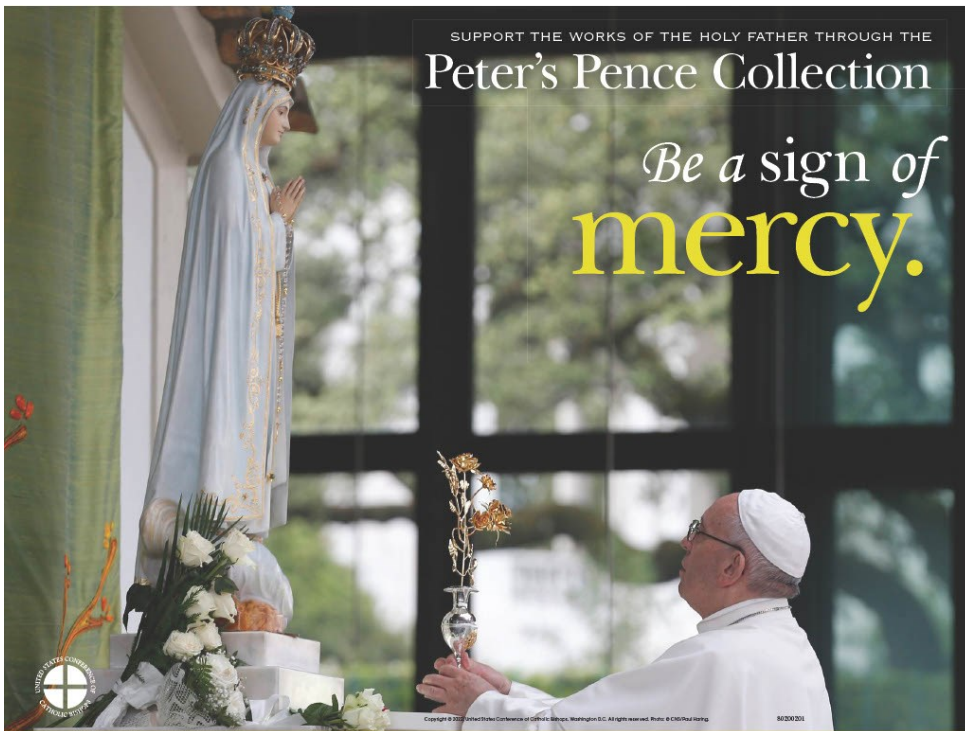


### You can fight high blood pressure
