This and That

People have asked how we go about making an appointment with you. Every priest has his own method.

I prefer to schedule my own appointments. Many people try to schedule an appointment with me when they see me in the gathering space before or after mass. The time before and after mass is a time for me to greet parishioners and guests who maybe visiting our parish and not the time to conduct parish business.

You can call the parish office and leave a message on my answering service. My extension is 102. Please do not call the emergency line to make an appointment with me. I usually will return calls when I am in the office or the following day.

With the office being closed on Fridays, I have decided to take Friday as my day off. I have been known to pop into the office on a Friday to catch up on work. The Sisters I had in grade school often referred to those days as “catching up on seat work”.

People will often ask me after I visit someone in the hospital or nursing home: How is Mr. or Mrs. Smith doing? My answer is I can’t tell you. Because people in hospitals and nursing homes are protected by the HIPPA law. Simply put the HIPPA law is a privacy law. For example, your neighbor or friend cannot call me and ask me to go and visit a person in the hospital. Only the person themselves or a blood relative can call and request that I visit their loved one.

I would also remind you that all hospitals have a pastoral care department. I would ask that you call the pastoral care department when you or a loved one are admitted to the hospital. They are there to respond to your needs.

Gone are the days when the hospital would call the parish, give the name of the person, their room number and their diagnosis. That is no longer done. The person’s privacy is protected by HIPPA. In the age of social media, we have grown accustomed to having all the information available at our fingertips at any given time. Protecting and respecting person’s privacy is more important now than it has ever been.

I hope everyone has a joyous week and that you set aside some time to appreciate this beautiful summer season.

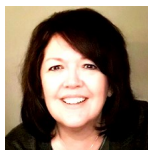

In our readings today, Zechariah foretells the coming of a “king” who is “meek.” St. Paul counsels the Romans to live in humility according to the Spirit, forsaking

earthly desires. Jesus tells his disciples that humility is necessary to know the Father and to learn his ways, sharing our burdens with him who provides rest. That is a lot of reminders that it is in God that we live and that we are dependent not on ourselves but on God.

In our society, we tend to regard meekness as weakness. Those who are meek never assert themselves, never get their way, and seem to always end up in last place. But clearly this is not what Zechariah means when he writes that our king would be meek yet would rule to the ends of the earth. Nor is it what Jesus means when he says, “I am meek and humble of heart” (Matthew 11:29). Webster’s defines meek as enduring difficulties with patience and without resentment. Jesus exemplifies this definition; he is the fulfillment of Zechariah’s prophecy. Zechariah’s words remind us of Jesus when he entered Jerusalem. There he would endure crucifixion and death—with patience and without resentment. Jesus models for us how to face our own trials - with more patience and with less resentment.

Of course, that is a challenging undertaking! To make our trials easier to endure, Jesus assures us that his yoke is easy and his burden light. Clearly he is not speaking of what he would be facing himself, for his own yoke was exceedingly difficult and his own burden was uniquely heavy. But because he has endured the cross and grave, we know that he can carry our own burdens, no matter how difficult we may find them. We do not have to carry them alone. Jesus can and will carry any difficulty we have.

Jesus says something else between speaking of meekness and burdens: “Learn from me” (11:29). Indeed, from him we can learn how he was able to endure every burden he faced with patience and resolve. He did so because he so loved the Father that he was willing to do God’s will, no matter the consequences. He did so because he loved all us sinners so much that he was willing to pay the ultimate cost to save us. As we learn and grow more and more like Jesus, may our love of God and love of neighbor give us the strength to share in the burdens of those in need, those on the margins of society, those who lack the resources needed to survive.

As St. Paul reminds us, we live in the Spirit. The Spirit calls us to serve God and humanity, not just ourselves. We pray that our efforts in service may bring others to Jesus so that he may ease their suffering. This week, pray for those in need and ask yourself who you can reach out to in order to lighten their burden. Take time to act on that prayer, share the yoke of another, lending a helping hand or a listening ear. In our meekness and humility, may we conform our lives more closely to Jesus and seek to be his body in the world.

FATIMA

To begin our WYD pilgrimage, our group, Macomb Unido, will be visiting Fatima on July 25, 2023.

Fatima is the most important pilgrimage site in Portugal. This is where an apparition of Mary appeared to three shepherd children, six times over the course of six months, culminating in the Miracle of the Sun, which was witnessed by over 70,000 people.

These events draw many millions of pilgrims and visitors to Fatima every year, and at the site of the apparitions, a massive religious complex has been constructed. Within this complex is a beautiful Basilica, a colossal church, a sprawling plaza, and the tiny chapel Mary instructed to be built.

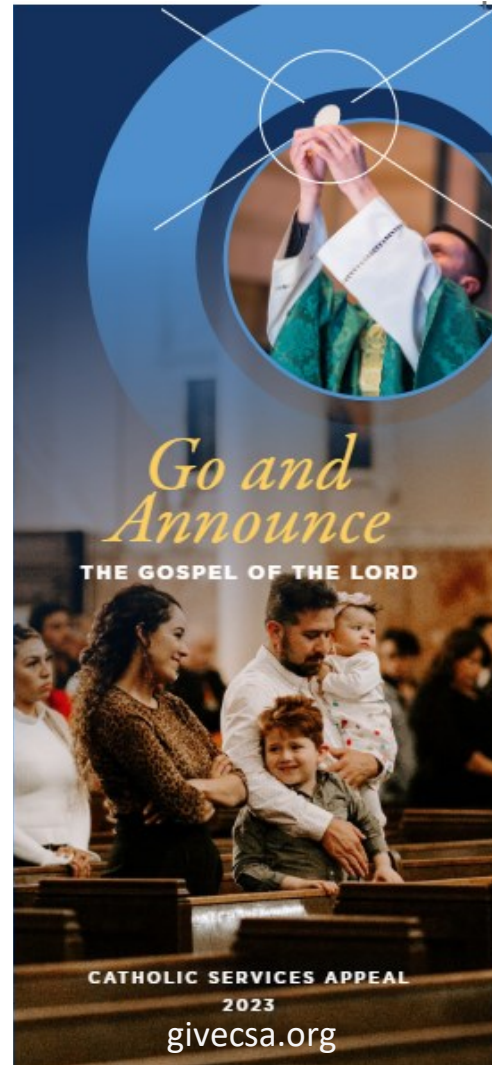
