Funeral Protocol

From time to time, I put this reprinted article in the bulletin for those parishioners who are new to St. Jane Frances de Chantal and to remind all of us of the protocol that works best at St. Jane Frances de Chantal in regards to funerals.

Since my arrival at St. Jane Frances de Chantal, we have had our share of funerals. I would like to share with you funeral protocol in the event that you find yourself planning a funeral for a loved one. This is the time for the church to minister to you. The death of a loved one can and is difficult and the Funeral Ministry Team at St. Jane Frances de Chantal is here to assist you in any way that we can.

Once a death occurs, please call the funeral home of your choice. Once you have made contact with the funeral home, have the funeral home call St. Jane Frances de Chantal and ask for me. Myself, together with the funeral home will set the date. We will always try to honor the wishes of the family. Funerals are scheduled at 10:00 am, with the body lying in state in the chapel at 9:30am.

After you have met with the funeral home, please call the parish and set a time to meet with me to pick out the readings and music for the funeral liturgy. I will also ask for some background information about the deceased. Of note, eulogies or sharing of memories are not permitted at church and should be done at the funeral home the night before the funeral. From my experience the funeral home is a more relaxed atmosphere to share memories of a loved one.

The day of the funeral, members of the Funeral Ministry team will be there to answer any questions you may have. They will also instruct those who are reading at the Mass and others who were asked to participate in some way at the Mass. They will guide you through the whole of the liturgy.

I would like to thank the Funeral Ministry Team for all that they do. It is a great ministry to the families who are grieving the loss of a loved one. Lastly, a person does not have to be a member of St. Jane Frances de Chantal to be buried from St. Jane Frances. One of the corporal works of mercy is to bury the died and everyone has the right to a Christian burial. May we pray for those who have died because someday someone will be praying for us.

ADULT FORMATION OPPORTUNITY SEASON 2 OF *THE CHOSEN*

Last Lent we began a journey to encounter Jesus in a different way, gathering to watch and discuss the popular series about the life of Christ, *The Chosen*.

A good number of people enjoyed the series and the enlightening discussions after each episode that allowed for a deeper understanding of the Scriptures as well as a variety of viewpoints.

What's *The Chosen*?

“As the biggest crowdfunded project in TV history, *The Chosen* is the first-ever multi-season show about the life of Jesus. This series allows viewers to see the life of Jesus through the eyes of those that knew Him. Follow the transformations of His followers through the ministry of Jesus as He journeys to change the world.” The series “hopes to take you deeper into gospel stories by retelling and expounding on the character and intentions of Jesus and those who knew Him.” (angel.com)

Many of you may have already watched the series as it is currently available via website and app, with three complete seasons available (season 4 is currently in production). Our goal in gathering is to watch together and enter into dialog to deepen the experience and grow in relationship with others and Jesus. We will watch and discuss **Season 2 of *The Chosen*** this fall; there will be two sessions each week, one on Monday evenings from 6:30pm-8:00pm from September 18th through November 6th. The second session will be on Thursday afternoons from 2:00pm-3:30pm beginning September 21st and ending on November 9th. Both sessions will show the same episode; the Thursday afternoon session will repeat the Monday evening session. You can feel free to move between sessions as your schedule permits.

We gathered with 1.5 million other pilgrims from around the world.

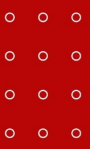

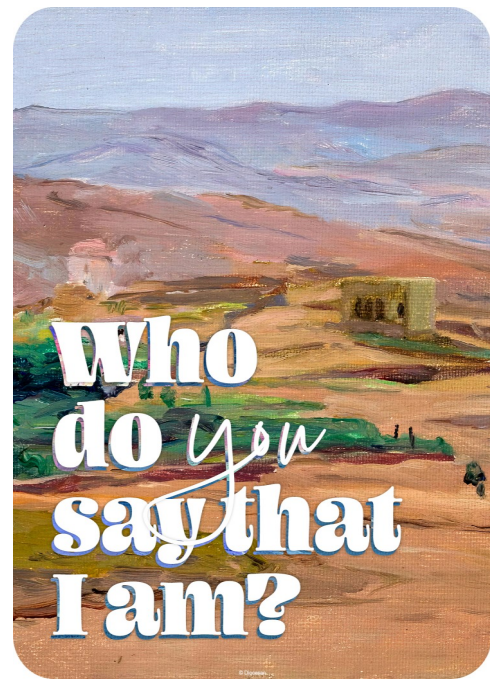

**Attention all St. Jane Frances de Chantal Volunteers
Safe Environment Policy Update**

The Archdiocese of Detroit has updated the Safe Environment Policy. Effective immediately, all employees and volunteers must read and digitally sign a Code of Conduct document, take Protecting God’s Children (PGC) Training, and have a background check completed. Current volunteers who have had PGC Training in the past will need to be recertified. This can be accomplished online. You can log into your account at virtusonline.org that you created when you signed up for PGC and it will prompt you to read the Code of Conduct document, digitally sign it, and it will then guide you through the process. All new volunteers will be required to take a PGC Training session either in person or on Zoom. Go to virtusonline.org to set up a new account and it will prompt you to sign up for PGC Training. Background checks need to be done every year. Please pick up a Background Check Form in the parish office, complete it, and return it to Jody Gazo. Teen volunteers will now be required to complete a Virtus online workshop. Teen volunteers will be asked to set up an account on virtusonline.org, and they will be prompted to put in their birthdate and Virtus will assign them the Healthy Relationships for Teens 2.0 module. 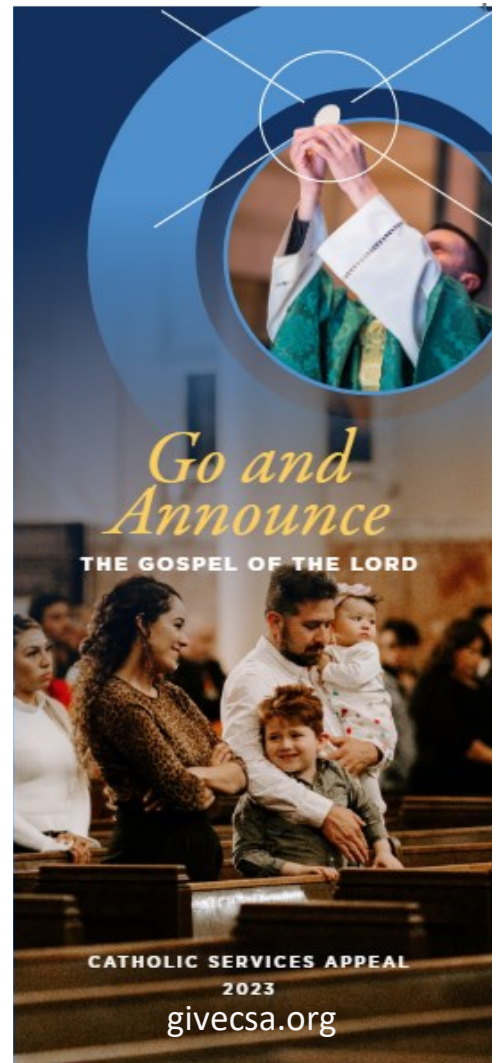
