## Financial Report

Every year, each parish within the Archdiocese of Detroit has to report on the finance condition of the parish to

the parishioners. This is usually done at the weekend Mass as well as to provide a brief financial report in the bulletin. As you can see the parish of St. Jane Frances de Chantal is in good financial condition.

I would like to thank the parish staff, the Parish Council and the Finance committee for the work they do to keep expenses down and the parish plant in pristine condition. I would also like to thank each one of you for your generosity over the past years. Your generosity has allowed us to take care of maintenance issues when they first arise and has also allowed us to put money in our savings account.

As you will see in the summarized financial report, we have been able to save a substantial sum of money over the years. I refer to these savings as an "emergency savings account". In the event that a major repair has to be addressed, say a new roof on the church or fixing the parking lot, the money in the emergency savings account would cover the cost of those repairs. Thus a special collection would not be needed because the money was already put aside for that purpose.

When we put the budget together for the new fiscal year the staff, together with the Parish Pastoral Council and the Finance committee, do a "walk around" the parish buildings and grounds to see what areas might need to be addressed in regards to repairs. Preventative maintenance allows us to address repairs before they become too large and costly. It also allows us to save money when the issues that need repair are done sooner rather than later.

Again I wish to thank you for your continued generosity to the parish. It is a sign of your commitment and love for the parish. As we move forward may we never cease praising God for the many ways He has blessed us and the parish of St. Jane Frances de Chantal

### EUCHRE NIGHT: **HAPPY HALLOWEEN!**

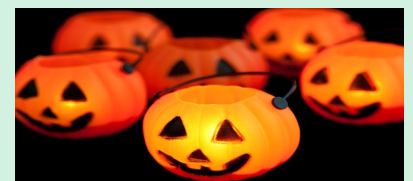
**WHEN:** Saturday, October 15<sup>th</sup>, from 5:00pm until about 10:00pm

You are likely familiar with the Missalettes that many churches still use. I have one and I like to look months ahead and plan music. At the beginning of the Sunday Mass section, there is always a Reflection and I

would like to share with you a sentence from today's message: "Daily life is rich in opportunities for storing up treasure in Heaven."

Pondering this, what do I truly treasure? What is it that you treasure? Is it your spouse, your family, your children or your friends? Maybe it's your home, your car or the clothing you wear. Is it what you love to do....your work or hobbies? Attending Mass, praying or joining in church activities? I suppose it can be all of those, but there is one treasure that is common to us all and we probably take it for granted: time. Every day we are given 24 hours and we can choose to use them or waste them. Each day is an opportunity to do good, to make up for past transgressions, or to learn something new, or not. Life is a gift and sometimes you don't realize just how precious it is.

Perhaps retirement isn't exactly mentioned in this passage, but I believe it applies. I arrived at St. Jane Frances on September 1, 2018. I found a wonderful parish full of faithful, caring and loving people. However, there comes a realization when you know it's time to leave.

After serving the people of the AoD at various churches for over 50 years, I am announcing my retirement. This will be my last weekend playing music at St. Jane Frances, though technically I am still here until September 30, 2022.

As most retired music ministers do, I will continue to sub wherever needed. I have been taking on more freelance writing work for HOUR Magazine, MI Golf Journal, Michigan Links, and Golf Digest. I will continue my charitable, veterans, military, and golf organizational efforts and, I hope to travel more.

## Priests' Pension Plan collection next weekend

The Archdiocese is blessed to have 89 retired priests who dedicated, in some cases, more than 50 years of their lives to caring for and ministering to others. Even in retirement, many continue to give of themselves in countless ways of service for which we are most grateful.

At age 70, priests in the Archdiocese of Detroit begin receiving a \$1,675 monthly pension and health and automobile insurance from the Priests' Pension Plan. The Archdiocese annually assesses each parish \$7,255 per priest serving there to support this fund.

Next weekend, September 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>, our parish will take up a special collection to help defray the cost of this assessment and to show our appreciation for those priests who have cared for us and ministered to us throughout the years. 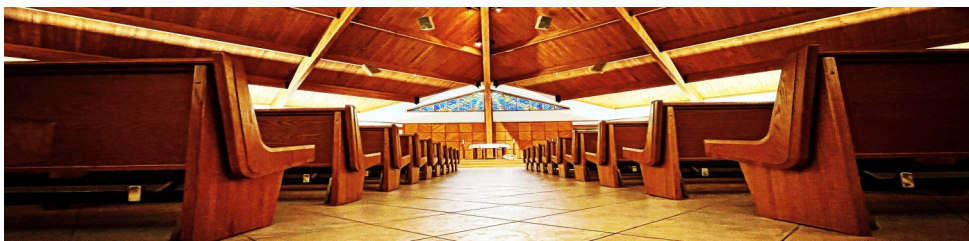
All money collected will stay at St. Jane Frances de Chantal to offset the costs of our own retired pastors.

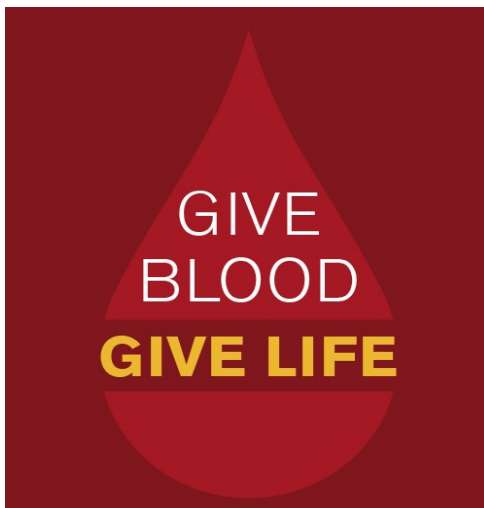
