

FATIMA: 100 Year Anniversary of Marian Apparitions



One hundred years ago, one of the most important series of apparitions in Church history took place. The Blessed Mother appeared to three shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal, six times between May and October 1917. Her calls to conversion and repentance are profound and were life-changing. Fatima has become one of the major pilgrimage sites in the world with over 4 million people a year visiting the basilica on the site of the appearances in Fatima. There has been an ever-increasing devotion to praying the Rosary as Our Lady requested.

Here at St. Jane Frances de Chantal we will be celebrating these appearances and promoting the prayer of the Rosary. We invite you to plan to take part in the upcoming events. We ask you to reflect on Our Lady's message that prayer and sacrifice can achieve world peace — a grave concern in the tense world we live in. As Sister Lucia (who as a child, was one of the three children who witnessed these apparitions) said, "the Rosary is the prayer which sustains and increases our faith."

Beginning the weekend of May 13th/14th we will have a 12" statue of Our Lady of Fatima available to take to your home for a week to use in your Rosary devotions. Families/Individuals will have the opportunity to sign-up for the statue for one week out of 22 weeks between May 13th, the date of the 1st apparition, and Oct. 13th, the date of the last apparition.

HEALTH MINISTRY MEMORY SCREENING

This screening is affiliated with the Alzheimer's Foundation of America.

A memory screening is a simple and safe evaluation tool that checks memory and other thinking skills. It can indicate whether an additional check up by a qualified healthcare professional is needed. The face-to-face screening takes place in private and will be done by a parish nurse. It consists of a series of questions and/ or tasks designed to test memory, language skills, thinking ability, and other intellectual functions. Results of the memory screenings are confidential. A memory screening is not used to diagnose any particular illness and does not replace consultation with a qualified physician or other healthcare professional.

These questions might help you decide if you should be screened. If you answer "yes" to any of them, you might benefit from a memory screening.

- Am I becoming more forgetful?
- Do I have trouble concentrating?
- Do I have difficulty performing familiar tasks?
- Do I have trouble recalling words or names in conversation?
- Do I sometimes forget where I am or where I am going?
- Have family or friends told me that I am repeating questions or saying the same thing over and over again?
- Am I misplacing things more often?
- Have I become lost when walking or driving?
- Have my family or friends noticed changes in my mood, behavior, personality, or desire to do things?

If a memory screening indicates possible problems, the person should follow up with a doctor or another qualified healthcare professional as soon as possible for a complete medical evaluation. Follow-up is important to identify the cause of the memory problems. Memory problems could be caused by Alzheimer's disease or other medical conditions. Some memory problems can be readily treated, such as those caused by vitamin deficiencies or thyroid problems. Other memory problems might result from causes that are not currently reversible, such as Alzheimer's disease.




