CHRISTLIFE IS COMING TO ST. JANE FRANCES!

We have all heard about evangelization quite a bit in the last few years. At Pentecost 2017, Archbishop Vigneron released the post-Synod Pastoral Letter titled *Unleash the Gospel* – a clear vision for the future of the Archdiocese of Detroit as an outward, mission-focused Church. This landmark letter followed a three-year spiritual renewal in preparing for a missionary transformation of the Archdiocese and the Church of Detroit.

As stated on the AOD website: "As a local Church in motion, we are resolved to follow the guidance of the Holy Spirit and become a band of joyful missionary disciples. We accept that this conversion requires a change in our culture such that every person, through a personal encounter with Christ, is formed as Christ's disciple and sent forth to give witness to the Gospel, strengthen their faith and bring hearts to Jesus."

We know that evangelizing can be scary. We often believe that we aren't equipped to speak to others about our life in Christ. Well, we understand that and are bringing a program to St. Jane Frances that will help you feel more comfortable and better equipped – ChristLife. This program will begin on September 24, 2018 with a seven-week process called "Discovering Christ." Discovering Christ is a process that creates a welcoming environment where members of a parish can bring their family, friends, or other guests to hear the Good News and personally encounter Jesus Christ. Each session includes a meal, a brief time of praise and worship, a video teaching and small group discussion. The high point of the course is a day retreat where participants have the opportunity to make a personal commitment to Christ and be renewed in the Holy Spirit.


I have experienced ChristLife as a participant and have had the pleasure of leading one as well. I was amazed and rejuvenated in my faith as both a participant and a leader. Most everyone who completed the program begged for more – they were "on fire for Christ!".

In the coming weeks, look for information including dates, topics covered and how to register for the Discovering Christ Program. Looking forward to becoming a band of joyful missionary disciples!

DISCOVERING CHRIST HAS TWO MAJOR GOALS:

To help participants enter into or renew a personal relationship with Jesus Christ, experience the love of God, and be empowered by the Holy Spirit to live as God's children and serve as His missionary disciples in the Catholic Church.

To give participants the relational support necessary to begin to live for Christ within the parish.

From Wisdom: "For he fashioned all things that they might have being;"


From Paul's letter to the Corinthians: "As you excel in every respect...may you excel in this gracious act also:"
