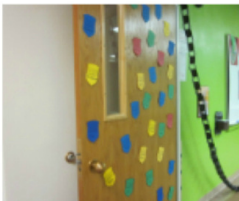




# ST. JANE FRANCES de CHANTAL PARISH

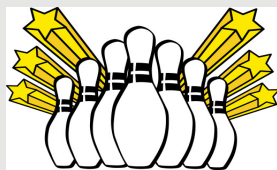

## Father Solanus Casey Beatification Set for November 18<sup>th</sup> at Ford Field in Detroit

The Capuchin Franciscan Order of St. Joseph in Detroit has announced that the date for the Father Solanus Casey beatification ceremony will be Saturday, November 18<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at Ford Field in Detroit. This follows the historic announcement by Pope Francis on May 4<sup>th</sup> that Father Solanus Casey will be elevated to Blessed in the Roman Catholic Church. Details on the Fr. Solanus Casey beatification ceremony, including ceremony time, will be released in the coming weeks and available at [solanuscasy.org/beatification](http://solanuscasy.org/beatification) and [aod.org](http://aod.org). Ticket information will be made available by August 15<sup>th</sup>. Ford Field will be configured to accommodate approximately 60,000 guests for the ceremony.

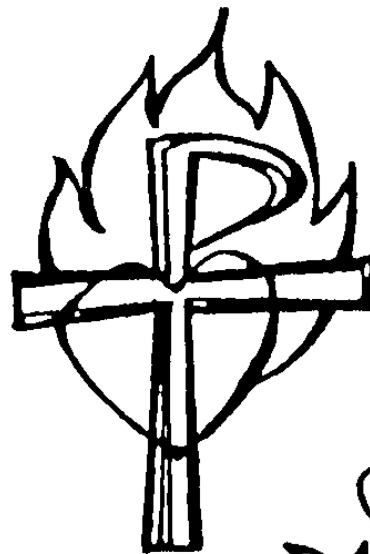

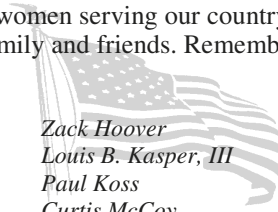
