





Join up to 17,000 volunteers in beautifying the neighborhood surrounding Sacred Heart Major Seminary, St. Charles Lwanga and St. Moses the Black Parish. This year's project, coming on the 50th anniversary of the 1967 uprising, serves not only as a powerful commemoration of the progress that has been made, but also the continued progress toward which we strive together.









Father Solanus Casey Beatification Set for November 18th at Ford Field in Detroit

The Capuchin Franciscan Order of St. Joseph in Detroit has announced that the date for the Father Solanus Casey beatification ceremony will be Saturday, November 18th, 2017 at Ford Field in Detroit. This follows the historic announcement by Pope Francis on May 4th that Father Solanus Casey will be elevated to Blessed in the Roman Catholic Church. Details on the Fr. Solanus Casey beatification ceremony, including ceremony time, will be released in the coming weeks and available at **solanuscasey.org/beatification** and **aod.org**. Ticket information will be made available by August 15th. Ford Field will be configured to accommodate approximately 60,000 guests for the ceremony.


