## THIS WEEK'S JERRY-ATRICS



This had been the weekend I had hoped to make an announcement regarding the new Director of Music. The parish entered into an agreement in principle with a musician who is employed at another parish with the Archdiocese of Detroit. The plan was the musician would start here at St. Jane Frances no later than the end of July. Late last week I was informed by the musician that after a period of personal reflection he had chosen a different path which takes him away from church ministry. As a result, we find ourselves back to square one in seeking applicants and beginning the interview process anew. This is obviously not the news I had hoped to deliver. I assure you we will continue to do our due diligence and interview any and all qualified candidates to fill the position in a timely manner. I will continue to keep you updated as we continue this process.

Pope Francis was recently quoted as saying *"Nobody gets to heaven without a letter of reference from the poor!"* In many respects, this quote captures something that many of the ancient prophets underlined centuries ago.

The great prophets of Israel had coined this mantra: *"the quality of your faith will be judged by the quality of justice in your land."* And the quality of justice in our land will always be judged by how "widows, orphans and the destitute" are cared for while we are alive and walk the face of the earth.

The phrase "widows, orphans and the destitute" was a code for the three weakest, most-vulnerable groups in society at that time. In essence, what the prophets were saying is that our judgment is dependent on how the poor fared during the time God gave us from the time we take our first breath to the moment when we draw our last breath.

That thought becomes even scarier when we see how Jesus strongly endorsed this view. We are told, in the Gospel of Matthew, that at the last judgment the Son of Man will separate people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. *"The sheep he will place on his right and the goats on his left. Then the Son of Man will turn to those on his right and say 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave me food. I was thirsty and you gave me drink. I was a stranger and you gave me welcome. I was naked and you clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me.'" When the ones who have failed to give food to the hungry, drink to the thirsty, clothing to the naked, welcome to strangers and care for the ill and those in prison are surprised to find out that they have been assigned a place for the devil and his angels, they are told "whatever you did not do for the least of my brethren, you did not do for me" they are shocked to learn of their eternal fate (Matthew 25:31-46).*

As we begin preparations to welcome our McRest Guests in just a few weeks, we are reminded of an essential part of the Gospel, equal to going to Mass on Sunday. Praying and striving to live a holy life is just not good enough. We too need a concrete reference from the poor.

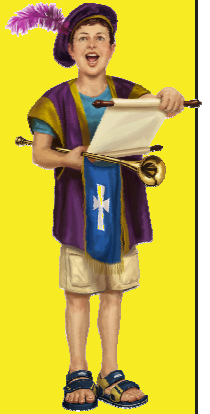


## Vacation Bible School

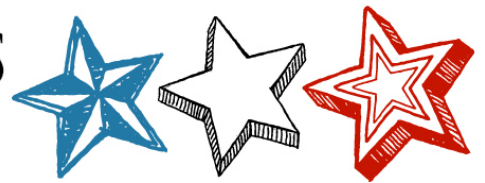

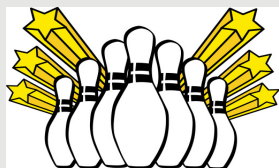
