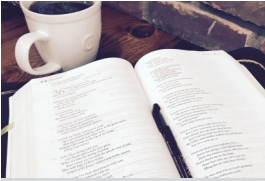

## WHEN A STRANGER ASKS FOR MONEY

At St. Jane Frances de Chantal we have a very active St. Vincent de Paul Society that provides food and resources to those in need. Anyone soliciting for money in our parking lot before/after Mass is doing so without permission from the parish. Please DO NOT GIVE CASH to any such individuals.

Instead, politely refer such individuals to speak with the receptionist in the parish office. The receptionist will contact one of the members of our St. Vincent de Paul society who will do an intake in order to determine if the request has validity. If the person refuses to do so they, in all likelihood, are not in need of legitimate assistance.

When you give money to a person who does not have permission to solicit people going into or out of church there is no way to guarantee the money is going towards the purpose they claim. The St. Vincent de Paul never gives cash to a person. A person in need, if it is determined that there is a legitimate request, can be helped by being given food, a voucher, or a check made payable to a utility company or landlord, if they are truly in need.



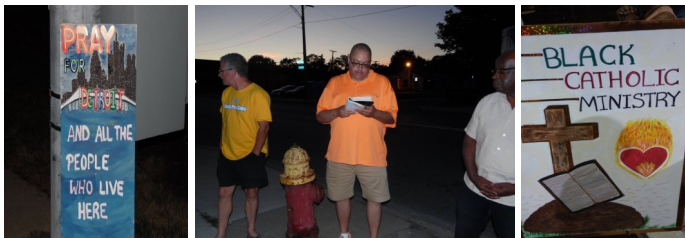

Getting involved in music ministry is not difficult. There are several ways in which you can serve the church with your time and talent. If you are considering ways to become more actively involved in the parish, consider joining the choir! Parish Choir rehearsals will begin September 6, 2017 at 6:30pm. I plan to have a meet and greet after our first rehearsal. If singing doesn't interest you, but you play an instrument, I welcome you to identify yourself to me with your instrument and level of proficiency at [musicsjparish@gmail.com](mailto:musicsjparish@gmail.com) so I can schedule music for the Instruments in Praise Ensemble.

On another note, I am a strong advocate for congregational singing. Singing provides unique aids to prayer. When we pray, we form the words in our mind and then speak them. However, this is such second nature to us that it can be done almost without thinking. To sing well requires careful formation of the words and notes. How easily we can mumble a Hail Mary? Not so singing Ave Maria. Furthermore, when we sing we add another step. After thinking and then forming the words, we then hear and enjoy them as they return to our ears in song. In this way we essentially pray twice: once as the orator and once as the congregation. Thus we are given the opportunity to focus more fully on the prayer we sing. Having full, active, and conscious participation greatly enhances your worship experience and helps me in my ministry. I come from a singing parish and have always appreciated when I encounter "noise" in the pews. So please, don't leave me hanging: SING!

My daughter Jennifer is being baptized this weekend at our home parish in Detroit. I can't wait to see you all next week!

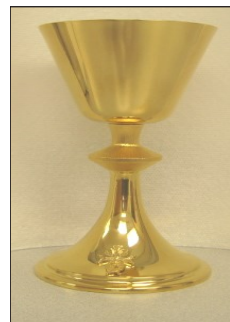

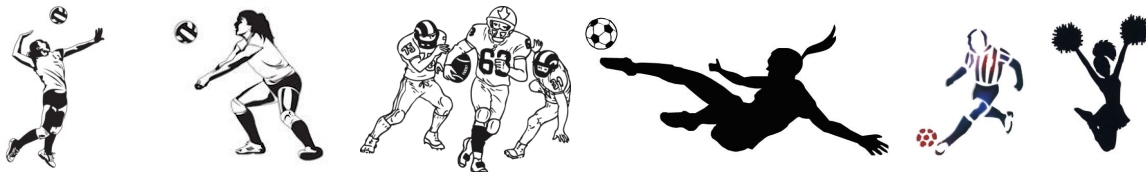

The Heart of Oak events begin at the Academy’s Field House, located at 1250 Kensington Road in Bloomfield Hills; the 5K route loops through residential Bloomfield Township, while the Kids Run, for ages 12 and under, takes place on the school’s athletic fields. Registration begins at 8:00am, the Kids 1-Mile Fun Run begins at 9:00am and the 5K Run and Family Walk begin at 9:30am.



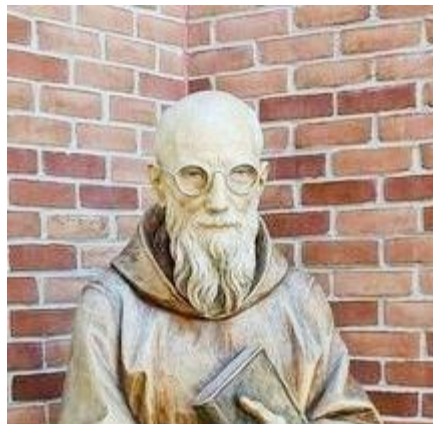
