LENTen Observation

The word Lent itself is derived from the Old English words *lencten*, meaning "Spring," and *lenctentid*, meaning "Springtide" and the word for "March," the month in which most of Lent takes place.

This year when I began to think of how I will observe Lent, it occurred to me that the word *lent* is the French word for "slow", or similarly *lento* is the Italian equivalent. I asked myself how being called to slowness might be a way to live out this Lenten season.

We have had such a short time between the Christmas season and Lent this year that I think many of us are feeling a bit rushed and unprepared. For me, I have decided to slow down a bit and reflect on what I can do to become the best "me" in time for the celebration of our Lord's resurrection. How can I deepen my prayer life? What can I do to reach out to others? How can I un-clutter my life? Slow down, breathe. How can I approach ministry so that I am most generous to those I minister to while at the same time recognizing the graces I receive from them? Slow down enough to see where God is in my life each day. Breathe, pray. Slow down, encounter Jesus. My Lent will be a time of deliberately doing these things as opposed to giving up something. Can you slow down and take time for some Lenten reflection?

Jerry will be assisting at the Reconciliation Service. Please take advantage of this opportunity in your Lenten preparations.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation: Revisited

February 15, 22, 29; 7:00pm - 8:30pm

If you have not participated in the sacrament of Reconciliation for a long time or do so with great reluctance, please know that you are not alone! In 2008, the Center for Applied Research in the Apostolate (CARA) at Georgetown University conducted a study entitled, Sacraments Today: Belief and Practice among U.S. Catholics. Regarding Reconciliation, the basic finding was that 75% of Catholics "report that they never participate in the sacrament of Reconciliation or that they do so less than once a year." (57)

In this great *Jubilee Year of Mercy*, I invite you to take part in this series during which we can explore and address reasons and concerns that keep you from celebrating this sacrament which is filled with grace, even as it might instill fear or discomfort in you. This is an opportunity to learn more about Reconciliation; there will be no judging you nor pressuring you.

1) You Are Not Alone:

I Don't Go to Confession Because...

This evening (February 15th) explores the reasons people give for not participating in the sacrament. Are these feelings valid? What is our understanding of the sacrament? What is truth about the sacrament: the theology, the affects of sin, forgiveness, mercy, grace?

2) So What Now?

This evening (February 22nd) explores what might still hold you back from the sacrament, review of the healing grace of the sacrament, examination of conscience, and practical matters of celebrating the sacrament.

3) What I See:

From My Side of the Confessional...

This evening (February 29th) explores the priest's experience in hearing people's confession. This does not mean a discussion of the sins that are confessed, but rather the humility, healing, joy, consolation, hope, grace and re-encounter with Christ that the priest witnesses as the confessor. After a brief power point presentation, Fr. Jerry Slowinski, pastor of St. Jane Frances de Chantal Parish, will share his personal reflections of his role as confessor.

It is the hope that you will leave this series open to the Spirit moving you towards the celebration of the Sacrament of Penance/Reconciliation and to experience the powerful love and compassion of Jesus. Register by contacting the parish office.

Step 2: Discuss the "On the way Home From Mass" question in the car and "Living the Word"

Step 3: After Mass, discuss the "On the way home from Mass" question.

ABOUT THE GOSPEL—Luke 4:1-13

After hearing His Father called Him "beloved Son" at His baptism, Jesus enters the desert. There, the devil tempts Him, challenging His true identity with the words: "If you are the Son of God...." Jesus know who He is. In the strength of the Holy Spirit, three times He resists the devil. We, too, are His beloved children of God by virtue of our Baptism, and the Holy Spirit dwells within us. We can draw on that strength during times of temptation, and ask our Father to deliver us from evil.

On the Way Home From Mass...

Dear Parents,

Please use these questions to help your child (ren) better understand today's Gospel.

- 1) Are you ever tempted to worship anything besides God?
- 2) Is anything more important to you than God?

NEXT WEEK'S GOSPEL—Luke 9:28b-36

...On the Way To Mass

Step 1: Read the gospel aloud, from the Bible, a smart phone, or tablet. Or find it at usecb.org.

Step 2: Discussion

1) When you pray, have you ever heard Jesus? What did He say? Have you ever seen Him? How did He look?

LIVING THE WORD

To mark this new season, place a violet cloth near your Bible. Cut a piece of card stock into two 4 1/2 x 11 cards. On one, write the word, "LENT" in violet and place it on the cloth. Recall that the Church gives us six weeks to prepare our hearts – through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving– for the glorious feast of Easter. Decorate the other card with the word "Alleluia!" and symbols of Easter. Bury it under the cloth as a reminder that we will not hear that word at Mass until Easter.


