As we begin this New Year, we will be hearing a lot about Families of Parishes. In November of last year, Archbishop Allen Vigneron appointed me as the moderator of our family of parishes. Our family consists of St. Rene Goupil, St. Jane Frances de Chantal, Sts. Cyril and Methodius, and Our Lady of Czestochowa.

Between now and July 1, 2022, the moderators of Wave II will be involved in a series of meetings to prepare for the July 1, 2022 date, which is the beginning of the new fiscal year within the Archdiocese of Detroit.

The four pastors of our family of parishes have been ministering together for the past three years in various aspects of parish life. A few examples are the communal penance services held during the seasons of Advent and Lent, as well as the reconciliation day that is held at Sts. Cyril and Methodius the week before Christmas and Easter.

This year, St. Rene Goupil and St. Jane Frances de Chantal share a Director of Faith Formation and will alternate the celebration of the sacrament of confirmation at each parish.

The pastors have also agreed that, when needed due to sickness or being out of town, we will cover for each other in the case of a funeral or other liturgical celebrations. When we first met in 2019, we all agreed to take a proactive stance, and we looked at various areas of parish life in which we could assist each other and share our resources.

As we all are aware, there is a decline in the number of priests—yet the spiritual needs of the people are being met despite the decline. When the people of God are in need of the ministry of a priest, one is usually available.

I would like to thank the parish staffs of our family of parishes—as well as the many volunteers who share their gifts and their talents together with priests. Your ministry to your parish enables your pastor to minister to the people of God as the priest he was ordained to be.

I will share with you more information as it comes available. Until then, let us lift each other up in prayer. Together, each of us is called to build up the Body of Christ as members of Christ's church.

Today we return to Ordinary Time, a short stretch before the season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 2, 2022. In these seven weeks before Lent, the liturgical color

of green returns to the worship space, and the readings reflect the living life of Christ.

The month of January includes the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, which is held on the third week of the month. This year, it begins on January 18, 2022 and concludes on January 25, 2022. During this yearly remembrance, we pray for unity across all Christian faiths, a response to Jesus' cry for unity: "that they may all be one. As you, Father, are in me and I am in you, may they also be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me" (John 17:21).

The Pontifical Council for Promoting Christian Unity has resources for this week of prayer, including daily reflections on Scripture and suggested prayers. They can be viewed online at **sjfparish.org**, at the bottom of the page, under "News."

The following prayer is found in the *Catholic Household Blessings & Prayers* and can be prayed daily, especially during this week of Prayer for Christian Unity:

Let us pray for all our brothers and sisters who share our faith in Jesus Christ, that God may gather and keep together in one Church all those who seek the truth with sincerity.

Almighty and eternal God,

you keep together those you have united.

Look kindly on all who follow Jesus, your Son.

We are all consecrated to you by our common Baptism.

Make us one in the fullness of faith, and keep us one in the fellowship of love. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

Amen.

FOLLOWING MARY, STAR OF THE NEW EVANGELIZATION

All Catholics are called to proclaim the victory of Christ, to unleash the Gospel in a world of people "who dwell in darkness and the shadow of death" (Lk 1:79). We could have no better model of a missionary disciple than Our Blessed Mother.

Our Lady unleashed the saving truth of the Gospel in the most literal way imaginable. The Word of God was born from her womb, shared in her flesh. Blessed Mary is what tradition has called the Theotokos, which is Greek for "God-bearer." She bore God's Son, brought him forth into the world, and proclaimed God's glory in words prayed by the whole universal Church: "My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord, my spirit rejoices in God my Savior" (Lk 1:46-47).

A question swiftly emerges: How can I imitate Mary in her motherhood? Fortunately, we have divine guidance to help us answer this question! We need to recall the time when Mary and other members of Jesus' family wanted to speak with him while he was teaching the crowds in Matthew 12. Jesus used the opportunity to forge new family bonds with his disciples, saying, "Whoever does the will of my heavenly Father is my brother, and sister, and mother" (Mt 12:50).

Christ's emphasis on doing the will of God plunges us deep into the mystery of his mission and his mother's share in it. Mary's last words in Scripture were an encouragement to obedience: "Do whatever he tells you." (Jn 2:5) Blessed Mary did not only call others to be obedient to God's will. She lived obedience with a pure and undivided heart. Mary spoke perhaps her best-known words at the Annunciation, welcoming God's messenger and pledging herself to his plan for her life: "Mary said, 'Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word'" (Lk 1:38).

We do need to be, in the words of Pope St. John Paul II, "new in ardor" as we live and share our faith today. Mary receives Gabriel's message. Mary is reactive when she expresses her great faith by speaking those words which made the whole Christian life possible because they welcome Christ into the world: "May it be done unto me according to your word."

These classes are free and require a computer or tablet with Internet access. **Registration is required**, and you only need to register once for all the classes.






ST. JANE FRANCES de CHANTAL FAITH FORMATION MEET THE CATECHIST: JACQUELINE LAROCCA


