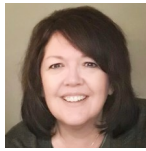

Have you ever wondered what it's like to participate more fully at Mass? Have you ever

wanted a closer look at what it's all about? Do you want to serve God and the people of St. Jane Frances de Chantal?

Well, the altar servers would like to invite you to join our ministry! We'll provide the training—all you have to do is show up with enthusiasm and a heart that's ready to participate in Mass in a new way.

### What does an altar server do?

- Serve as cross bearer or candle bearer
- Hold the priest's prayer book
- Help set up the altar
- Assist the priest in accepting the gifts of bread and wine
- Assist with the washing of hands
- Perform other duties such as carrying incense, carrying holy water for sprinkling, and special duties for the Easter and Christmas seasons

Mom/Dad/Guardian—this is a ministry that is perfect for our young people. It gives them a greater role at Mass and in the life of the Church. The schedule is set up and made available online and can be viewed via an app for your phone. You tell us what Mass you can serve at and how often. It can be as little as once a month, if that suits your schedules best.

If your child is interested but hesitant, *you too can serve!* It is a beautiful ministry to share with your children—you both will be enriched, and the community will have a wonderful witness to the love of family. ## SIX WEEKS WITH THE BIBLE

Are you interested in learning more about the Bible in a casual, sharing atmosphere? I am hoping to start a new group to explore God's word and reflect on how we might respond to it. This group would utilize a learning system called Six Weeks with the Bible by Loyola Press. Each six-week series will utilize a book that participants will purchase (for approximately \$10) that explores either a book of the Bible or a particular theme. We would begin with the Book of Genesis but would not be exploring the books of the Bible in order. The guide includes Scripture passages, insights from Church fathers and saints, questions for discussion and reflection, and prayer suggestions.

It doesn't matter if you have never studied the Bible before, or if you have had experience with Bible study—all are welcome! I am considering Tuesdays or Thursdays in the morning or evening as options, but I want to first gauge interest. 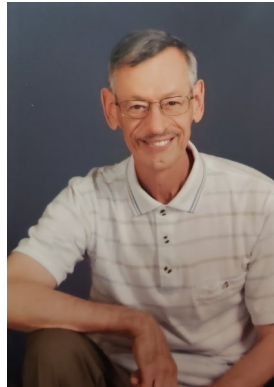

## ST. JANE FRANCES de CHANTAL FAITH FORMATION MEET THE CATECHIST: ED KUHLE

Hello, my name is Ed Kuhle, and I am a volunteer catechist in the Faith Formation program. I worked in parish ministry as a Director of Faith Formation for 48 years and retired in 2015.

My earliest memories of my faith life and church were handed down to me by my mother. She began to educate me in the faith in my earliest years. As a toddler, this education consisted of being the recipient of warm hugs and tender love, prayers before bedtime, being told simple Bible stories, and going to mass every Sunday. This education was woven seamlessly, sometimes perhaps unconsciously, into every moment of my early family life. This education preceded, accompanied, and enriched all the other forms of education in faith that I experienced through the years.



I think some of the highlights of my faith journey would be my Baptism, my mom, my First Holy Communion, my Confirmation, attending Catholic school, seeing Pope John Paul II in person at World Youth Day in Denver, Colorado, and my trip to Rome.

After retirement, I felt God calling me back to faith formation, this time as a catechist. I enjoy working with young people and want to share God's love with them and care for them. There is much to learn about the beauty and truth of our Catholic faith. I want to help them grow as a disciple of Jesus, to know and love their faith, and to help them foster a close and loving relationship with Jesus.

I would like to share with you this quote I like:

## WORLD MISSION SUNDAY COLLECTION

We will take up the collection for World Mission Sunday next weekend, **October 23 & 24, 2021**. The collection envelope is included in this bulletin.
