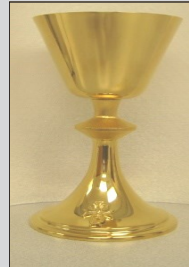

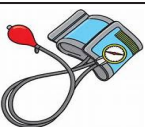
Soup Kitchen Ministry serves lunch at St. Leo's

These teams are for everyone, from those who have never played to the highly skilled.

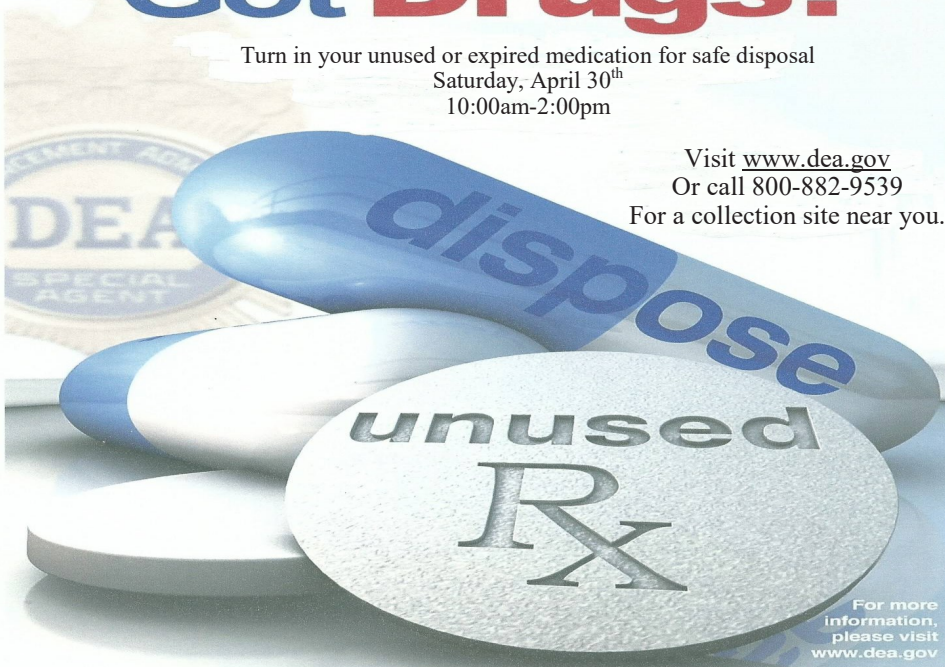
