radical overhaul from an inward, maintenance-focused church to an outward, mission-focused church. Please join us with your thoughts as we call upon the Holy Spirit to lead our archdiocese in a direction which will help us to *Unleash the Gospel* - which is the theme for Synod 16.

To put a Synod in some type of perspective, the last time the Archdiocese held such a gathering was in 1969. This is approximately 10 years before St. Jane Frances de Chantal ever existed. Chances are that this will be the only opportunity in our lifetime to be part of such an important process. In a parish of almost 1,500 families, it is my hope that the Fr. Page Activity Center will draw many parishioners to come forward to take part in our “**Parish Dialogue Gathering**”.
