

Archdiocese of Detroit's Holy Door of Mercy

Throughout the jubilee year, Holy Doors will be opened at the major basilicas of Rome, as well as cathedrals worldwide, including the Cathedral of the Most Blessed Sacrament in Detroit. Faithful who make a pilgrimage and pass through a holy door receive a plenary indulgence.

What is a Holy Door?

A Holy Door is a special rite used during a Jubilee Year, announced by a Pope. In his bull, Incarnationis Mysterium, proclaiming this Holy Year, Pope John Paul II stated that the Holy Door "...evokes the passage from sin to grace which every Christian is called to accomplish. Jesus said, 'I am the door' (John 10:7) in order to make it clear that no one can come to the Father except through Him. A very important symbolic act performed by each pilgrim has been to pass through the Holy Door.

Therefore to pass through the door from the outside is to pass from this world into the presence of God. Moreover, to pass through the door is to confess with firm conviction that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, the Lord, and the Savior who suffered, died, and rose for our salvation. With great courage, a person freely decides to cross the threshold leaving behind the kingdom of this world so as to enter the new life of grace of the Kingdom of God

Pray for the Pope

What is a Plenary Indulgence?

An indulgence is "a way to reduce the amount of punishment one has to undergo for sins" which may reduce either or both of the penance required after a sin has been forgiven, or after death, the time to be spent in Purgatory.

How do I receive a Plenary Indulgence?

To receive a plenary indulgence for walking through the Holy Door of Mercy, the pilgrim must go to confession, receive Holy Communion, detach themselves from sin, and pray for the pope. All these must be completed within several days (about 20) before or after the indulgenced act (walking through the Holy Door).

What is a Plenary Indulgence?

We suggest taking your time at each station, reflecting on the message and meaning of it in your own life. The pilgrimage can take anywhere from 30 - 45 minutes.

For those who are unfamiliar, MCREST stands for Macomb County Rotating Emergency Shelter Team and was founded to provide temporary emergency shelter for homeless men, women and children who are drug and alcohol free in Macomb County. Their goal is to provide guests the opportunity for successful transition to independence.

MCREST has over 25 years of continuous service to Macomb County's homeless population and has grown to over 90 churches today.

St. Jane Frances, as a member congregation of MCREST, has offered our Parish as a place that will provide services for up to 30 guests that allow them to concentrate on making strides to be successful in this transition. We will provide a warm bed, three hearty meals each day, shower facilities, laundry service, and transportation. Guests must agree to maintain sobriety, be drug free, and cause no threat to others.

To facilitate this activity we are organized into sub-committees, each headed up by a coordinator. Their responsibility is to inform and work with the volunteers on the tasks needed to be performed.

In addition to volunteers, we will also be in need of food, clothing, paper products, and miscellaneous items so that we can facilitate this program. We will have a display at a future date for these items.






