#### This and That

People have asked me: "How we go about making an appointment with you?" Every priest has his own

method. I prefer to schedule my own appointments. Many people try to schedule an appointment with me when they see me in the gathering space, before or after Mass. The time before and after Mass is a time for me to greet parishioners and guests who maybe visiting our parish and not the time to conduct parish business.

You can call the parish office and leave a message on my answering service. My extension is 102. Please do not call the emergency line to make an appointment with me. I usually will return calls when I am in the office or the following day.

With the office being closed on Fridays, I have decided to take Friday as my day off. I have been known to pop into the office on a Friday to catch up on work. The Sisters I had in grade school often referred to those days as "catching up on seat work".

People will often ask me after I visit someone in the hospital or nursing home: "How is Mr. or Mrs. Smith doing?" My answer is, "I can't tell you", because people in hospitals and nursing homes are protected by the HIPPA law. Simply put, the HIPPA law is a privacy law. For example your neighbor or friend cannot call me and ask me to go and visit a person in the hospital. Only the person themself or a blood relative can call and request that I visit their loved one.

I would also remind you that all hospitals have a pastoral care department. I would ask that you call the pastoral care department when you or a loved one are admitted to the hospital. They are there to respond to your needs.

Gone are the days when the hospital would call the parish, give the name of the person, their room number and their diagnosis. That is no longer done. The person's privacy is protected by HIPPA. In the age of social media having all the information available at our fingertips at any given time, protecting and respecting a person's privacy is more important now than it has ever been.

I hope everyone has a joyous week and that you set aside some time to appreciate this beautiful autumn season.

Bon mot: There are many gaps and voids, many unmet needs in our complex world.

I have always enjoyed finding God in all things, especially in nature. Whenever possible, I like to spend time near the water, which is a place of peace for me, a refuge from the challenges of life. I grew up near

Lake St. Clair and spent a lot of time at (what was then called) Metro Beach. I even had my first actual job there!

LAUDATO SI, On Care for Our Common Home is an encyclical written by Pope Francis in 2015. He begins the encyclical with a reference to the canticle of St. Francis of Assisi that "reminds us that our common home is like a sister with whom we share our life and a beautiful mother who opens her arms to embrace us" (1). Our common home is now suffering from the "harm we have inflicted on her by our irresponsible use and abuse of the goods with which God has endowed her" (2). In this letter to all citizens of the world, Pope Francis expresses the need for science and religion to come together with all peoples to protect the earth and her resources, given by God.

I share this as I watched a beautiful film on YouTube called The Letter that I would encourage you to consider watching. The film was produced by an organization called Laudato Si Movement and premiered at the Vatican on October 4<sup>th</sup>, the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi. The film powerfully dramatizes the dialogue and the conversion needed to combat climate emergency. The stories of four representatives of the world, one a young person who is a climate activist from India, an Indigenous Chief from the Amazon, a young man from Senegal, and a pair of scientists from Hawaii, all help to demonstrate both the effects of climate change and the efforts needed to build a community that recognizes the effects and forms alliances to care for our common home.

The film is about 80 minutes long with beautiful cinematography of our amazing earth, including examples of the heartbreaking stories of the devastation wrought by climate change.
