Advent Themes

We begin this third week of Advent with the anticipation that Christmas is soon approaching. When we began the season of Advent, we heard

from Luke's Gospel of Jesus telling his disciples to be watchful, stay alert.

Luke's Gospel presents us with four themes in our preparation for the feast of Christmas. Each of these themes enables us to reflect upon this season and points us to the birth of Christ. The themes that the scriptures present to us are preparation, joy, hope, and love.

Each one is a stepping stone for our celebration of Christ being born into the world. They are themes that allow us to focus on what is important in our lives. In my office, I have many mementos that I have received from people throughout my years of being a priest. In the early days of my priesthood, I received a framed piece of needlepoint. In every assignment I had, that framed needlepoint was the last thing I packed and the first thing I unpacked when I arrived at a new parish.

It serves as a point of focus for me when events or situations became overwhelming. Life can sometimes be overwhelming and we begin to feel pulled in various directions and we lose our focus. The words on the needlepoint help me to focus on what is important in my life and pulls me back to the events and situation at hand. Those three simple, yet powerful words are **family, faith, and friends**.

As we draw closer to our journey towards Bethlehem, let us prepare ourselves to receive Him who is our joy, our hope, and our love.

We have now entered the second half of the Advent season-Gaudete Sunday! “The Third Sunday of Advent (Like the Fourth Sunday of Lent) is a day of joy in the midst of our spiritual preparations for Christmas.

It is traditionally called Gaudete Sunday, from the Latin of the Entrance Antiphon for today. The antiphon captures the mood of the entire liturgy as we move into the second part of Advent: there is a sense of joyful expectation, an awareness that the fulfillment of God’s great plan for us is near” (*Sourcebook for Sundays. Seasons and Weekdays, 2020*).

Tomorrow, December 12th, is the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, the patroness of the Americas. On the American continent, Marian devotion is frequently centered around the figure of our Blessed Mother as she appeared in December of 1531 to the native American Saint Juan Diego at Tepeyac Hill in the area of modern-day Mexico City. Our Blessed Mother actually appeared four times to Saint Juan Diego and once to his dying elderly uncle, Juan Bernardino. The fourth appearance to Saint Juan Diego was the most wonderful. A brief account of the apparitions will help to appreciate better God the Father’s purpose in sending the Blessed Mother to the American continent at Tepeyac and the important meaning of devotion to Our Lady of Guadalupe.

The first apparition took place on December 9th, which at that time was the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception in the Spanish Empire, of which Mexico was then a part. Our Blessed Mother appeared to Saint Juan Diego, an older native American who had recently lost his dear wife. Juan Diego himself died in 1548, seventeen years after the apparitions, at the age of 74. On May 6, 1990, Blessed Pope John Paul, during his second pilgrimage as Pope to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe, declared Juan Diego blessed. Christmas Wafers: The Christmas wafer commemorates a custom that is many centuries old. Oplatek (from the Latin “Oblatum” – Holy Bread) is believed by some to emanate as far back as the “manna” of Exodus 16:31 and is sometimes referred to as the Bread of Angels. Shared at the Christmas Vigil meal, the breaking of the Christmas wafer offers best wishes to family and friends. Christmas wafers are now available in the gathering space. A donation of \$1 per package of 4 wafers is appreciated.

THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT Family Page

Today is the third Sunday in Advent. Advent is a special time in the church year. It is a time when we prepare ourselves for the coming of Jesus. We prepare ourselves for the coming of Jesus born as a baby in Bethlehem. We prepare ourselves for the coming of Jesus among us here and now. We prepare ourselves for the coming of Jesus in glory at the end of time. God sent Jesus, born as a baby in Bethlehem. When Jesus was born, an angel said to the shepherds, "I bring you Good News of great joy." The coming of Jesus is the coming of joy. God can work through each of us to bring joy to others.

Discuss as a family:

- If you were planning the biggest party ever, what would you include?
What would you do?
- What brings you joy?
- How can you bring joy to someone this week?

ACTIVITY: Today we are going to make "Joy Spinners." Cut a circle out of a piece of cardstock or cardboard. Write the word "joy" on both sides and decorate it using bold colors. When finished decorating, poke 2 holes close together in the center of the circle and thread about 32 inches of yarn through one hole and then back through the second hole. Tie the loose ends together. Pull the loop so there's an equal length of yarn on each side. Hold the ends of the loops and move your arms in a circular fashion to twist the strands of yarn. When the strands are tightly twisted, quickly pull the ends against each other; the circle will spin, and the designs will have a different appearance.

Color the first two candles (those labeled hope and peace) either blue or purple. If you use blue, color the candle labeled joy blue. If you use purple, color the candle labeled joy pink.
