World Day of the Sick

Every year on February 11th, the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes the Universal Church

celebrates the World Day of the Sick. It is a day in which we remember those individuals in our life who are ill. Praying for the sick is one of the seven Corporal Works of Mercy. Praying for those who are ill reminds us that we belong to a community and we continue to lift up those in our community who are in need of prayer.

As it is important to pray for those who are ill, it is also important to pray for those who are caregivers. At some point in our life, each of us will become a caregiver for a loved one or have been a caregiver to a spouse or friend.

Those who have been a caregiver will tell you that sometimes it can become very taxing and exhausting to care for a loved one who is terminally ill. I recall when my mother was undergoing chemotherapy, my siblings and I would share the responsibility of taking our mother to her doctor's appointments. That sometimes meant that we had to rearrange our schedules to take her to her various appointments. Sometimes that was easier said than done, but it all worked out in the end.

After my mother's death, my siblings and I would talk about those appointments and even though some were challenging at times those three years were graced-filled and God gave us the strength when we needed it the most.

When we celebrate the World Day of the Sick, let us be mindful and lift up in our prayers not only the infirmed, but also those who care for them. I share with you a prayer I recite every day: Oh Lord, I lift up in prayer all those people who are most in need of your attention today. This prayer is a reminder to me that others are more in need of God's attention than me.

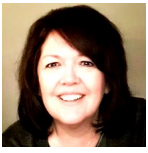

Lent is Coming – Ash Wednesday Imposition of Ashes

Lent begins this week, with Ash Wednesday on February 14th this year. We will have Mass at 8:00am and three additional opportunities to receive ashes at a Liturgy of the Word at 12:15pm, 4:00pm, and 6:00pm.

Ashes will be distributed in the usual way. When you approach the minister, he/she will say: “Repent and believe in the Gospel” or “Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return.” Ashes will then be placed on your forehead. No response is called for.

The message of the ashes remains the same: we are creatures of the earth, “remember you are dust”, and our earthly life will pass away. But we are also baptized people on a journey to “turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel.” At the liturgy of Ash Wednesday, we receive ashes and hear Matthew’s Gospel that explains that we are to cultivate three Lenten practices: fasting/abstinence, prayer, and almsgiving. These practices provide a structure to our penitential season. As we hear the message and receive the ashes on our foreheads, may we embark on a Lent that brings us ever closer to our loving and merciful God.

Stations of the Cross

Please join us each Friday in Lent at 6:30pm, in the main worship space, for Stations of the Cross. Please note the time as it is different from some previous years. Fr. Tony will lead the Stations this Friday.

Remote Stations of the Cross: If you cannot join us each Friday of Lent here at our parish, there are two options available online at sjfparish.org/sotc. The first is a video of Fr. Tony leading the Stations of the Cross which includes a link to the booklet he is using. The second option is *The Way of the Cross: A Prayer for Hope and Healing Amidst a Global Pandemic* by Zach Stachowski. The booklet is available on our website along with a link to the guided prayer: a YouTube video where the prayer is spoken, accompanied by pictures.

Lenten Reflection Books

Both the Little Black Books and two reflection books are available for the season of Lent in the gathering space. The Little Black Book contains six-minute reflections on the Passion According to Luke. The reflections begin February 11th and continue through Easter Sunday. We also have a supply of two other booklets this year; the booklets contain daily reflections from Ash Wednesday through Holy Saturday. These booklets are a great resource for learning more about your faith and for deepening your relationship with Jesus through prayer. Suggested donation for each of the books is \$2.

Do you love to read and are interested in books that spark spiritual discussion?

Join our Book Club!

The Book Club meets on the second and fourth Thursday of each month, from 10:30am – 12:00pm in the lower level of the parish offices. Each book that our group has read has brought something different to our continued conversion, forming us ever closer in relationship to God and each other. Our next book is *All the Light We Cannot See* by Anthony Doerr. The publisher’s description: “Winner of the Pulitzer Prize and National Book Award finalist, the beloved instant New York Times bestseller and New York Times Book Review Top 10 Book about a blind French girl and a German boy whose paths collide in occupied France as both try to survive the devastation of World War II.”

We will begin discussing this book on Thursday, February 22nd. The method we use is to read a small number of chapters at a time, allowing us to discuss the novel in greater detail. All are welcome, please just give me a call or an email to let me know to expect you and to send you the first reading assignment. Please plan to bring a copy of the book, it is available for purchase at most bookstores, including Amazon.

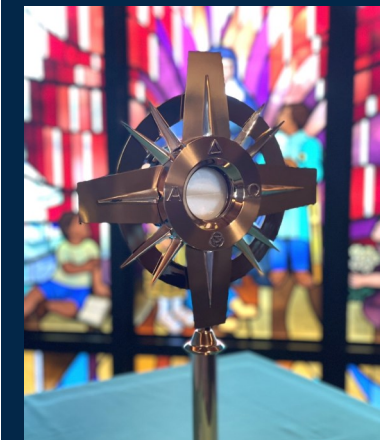
