Lent

On Ash Wednesday we embarked upon the season of Lent. As we, the parish community of St. Jane Frances de Chantal, begin our Lenten journey, may we pray for each other during this season but may we also lift up in prayer those people who are most in need of God's attention.

Recently, I read an article from America Magazine, a weekly Catholic periodical published by the Jesuits. The article is titled: 'Lent May Once Again Don Its Public Mask' This article was written in 1978 and reprinted in last week's edition of America and asks the question: What relevance does Lent have for Catholics?

The author reminds us that the three disciplines of Lent, namely fasting, almsgiving, and prayer, are to enable us to renew or refresh our relationship with God but also to move us outwardly into society and the world, to the people who are our brothers and sisters. I often use the example that food donations to the food pantry are very generous during the Christmas and Easter seasons. People are most generous at those seasons of the year, and how wonderful that is to see. However the needs of the poor and needy are year round. The good works we do are not meant to be done only in a particular season of the church's year. The good works that we perform during the season of Lent must become a part of our life and ministry as children of God.

The author states in the article, "Lent calls us to step out of the ordinary precisely so that we can step back into it with eyes opened and hearts renewed. The tradition has always emphasized the practical aim of Lenten self-denial: a greater openness and sensitivity to the needs of others."

He goes on to say: "Lent is, after all, the season of spring, of new life. Although its image may bear some cheerless connotations, its reality is refreshing. As American Catholics rediscover its ritual effectiveness, Lent may once again don its public face. And American society just might take notice". (Editorial Feb. 11,1978)

OPPORTUNITY TO RECEIVE THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

Ss. Cyril and Methodius will have two opportunities for the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Monday, March 25th, from 10:00am-12:00pm and from 6:00pm-9:00pm. As always, the Sacrament is available here at St. Jane Frances each Tuesday from 5:30pm-6:30pm.

WASHING OF THE FEET

At the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, March 28th at 7:00pm, Fr. Tony will wash the feet of 12 parish members. The foot washing on Holy Thursday may seem somewhat strange and old-fashioned. The church has kept it in the liturgy for good reason. As Christ washed the feet of his disciples at the Last Supper, emphasizing for them the connection between Eucharist and service to others, this ritual remains in our liturgy for the same reason. It is to emphasize that Eucharist is not separate from service, but that they are inextricably bound together. The essential nature of Holy Communion is unity, not only with God, but also with one another. Please prayerfully consider participating - having your feet washed in this way is a powerful and humbling encounter with the heart of discipleship! If you would like to participate in this beautiful act of service, please contact me via phone or email.

GOSPEL: Mark 9:2-10

Then Jesus took Peter, James, and John and led them up a high mountain apart by themselves. And he was transfigured before them, and his clothes became dazzling white, such as no fuller on earth could bleach them. Then Elijah appeared to them along with Moses, and they were conversing with Jesus. Then Peter said to Jesus in reply, "Rabbi, it is good that we are here! Let us make three tents: one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." He hardly knew what to say, they were so terrified. Then a cloud came, casting a shadow over them; from the cloud came a voice, "This is my beloved Son. Listen to him." Suddenly, looking around, they no longer saw anyone but Jesus alone with them. As they were coming down from the mountain, he charged them not to relate what they had seen to anyone, except when the Son of Man had risen from the dead. So they kept the matter to themselves, questioning what rising from the dead meant.

REFLECTION

We will one day see Jesus in His glory, but that is not now. Right now, we need to listen to Jesus, listen to the Gospel message and know that we are all part of Lent's salvation story. Be happy and rejoice in that, no matter how difficult things may be. Know the people in your life you can trust.

ACTIVITY

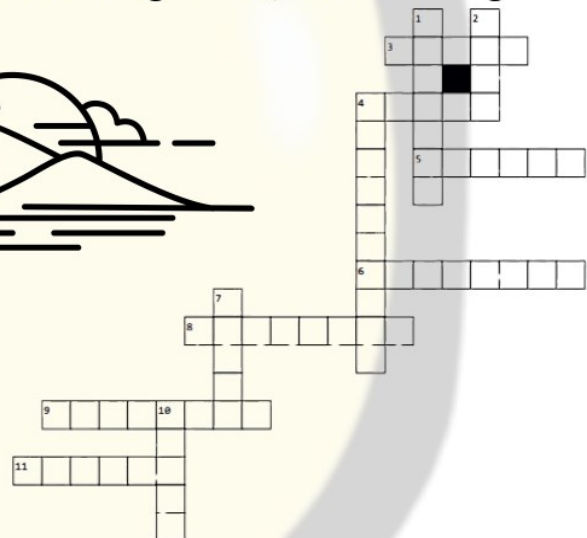
- 1) If you could spend one day with any 3 people, living or dead, who would you want to spend it with and why? Have all family members write down their list and share your answers.
