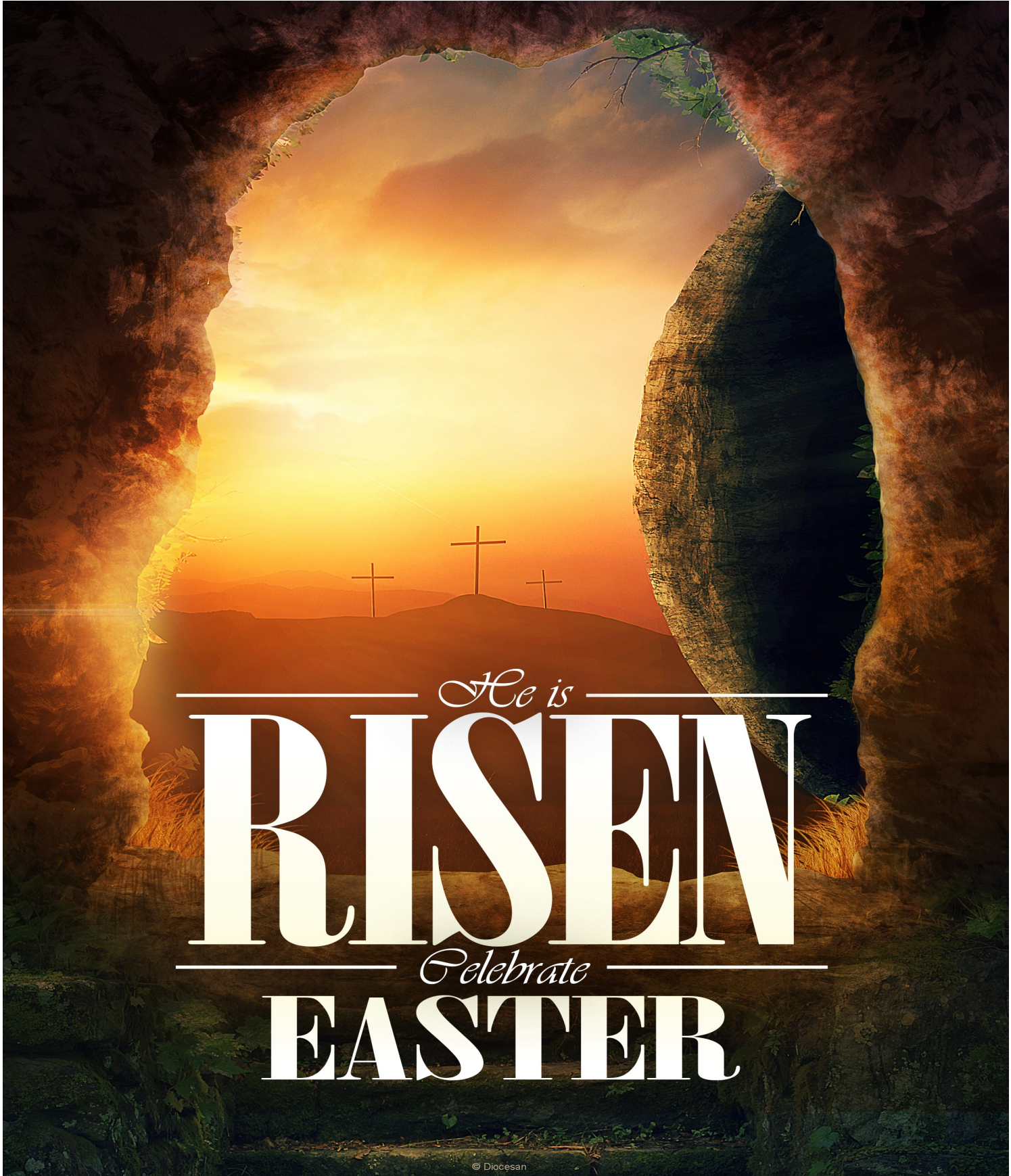

Easter

On behalf of the parish staff of St. Jane Frances de Chantal, I wish you and your family and friends a most joyous and blessed Easter. When you gather with your family and friends may you give thanks to God for all the people in your life who, in their own way, enrich and enhance your life. As I have said many times, God places people in our lives for a reason.

I also wish to welcome all those people who have come from places near and far to be with family and friends to celebrate Easter. I pray that your time with your family and friends is a memorable time. When the time comes for you to return to your own homes, may your trip be a safe one.

Easter is a joyous time, the snow is gone, new life is all around us, the flowers are in bloom and the nice weather will soon be upon us. It's also a time in which the words that Jesus spoke to his disciples have been fulfilled. The Son of Man will be put to death but will rise in three days. He has Risen as He said.

There is a story told about a priest who gave the shortest homily one Easter Sunday morning. On Easter morning, parishioners were gathering in the church, children dressed in their Sunday go to meeting clothes and the day was sunny and warm a nice Easter morning.

The priest of the parish read the Gospel for the Easter Mass. He kissed the Book of the Gospels and proceeded to descend the steps of the altar. He cleared his throat and said to the congregation: I am going to give you the shortest homily you ever heard as we celebrate the Great Feast of Easter.

He said: either you believe that Christ has Risen from the tomb, or you don't. The choice is yours. And with that said he continued with the Mass.

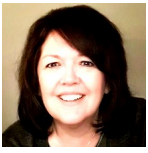
Indeed, Christ has risen from the tomb, he told his disciples He would. Sometimes the easiest choices are the most challenging. For forty days of Lent, we have been preparing to celebrate this day. We are like Peter and John who, after being told by the women the tomb was empty, went to the tomb, peered in and saw for themselves that indeed the tomb was empty. They saw and believed.

As we go about our work and leisure may we take the time to see the many ways in which God reveals the Risen Christ to us. Happy Easter, Wesolego Alleluja, Pasque Felice, Feliz Pascua.

Alleluia! He is Risen!

With great joy, let us pray,

O God, who on this day,

Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia. Christ is risen indeed!

Lent is officially ended – have we been transformed? Remember, Lent isn't a 40 day fix. When we take time to grow closer to Jesus, our habits formed during Lent can continue to enrich our lives. During the season of Easter, spend time in prayer and reflection on all that has changed in you. Here are a couple of questions to ponder:

How have I encountered the risen Lord: through God's word, through the Eucharist, through my contact with others, through prayer? How will I bear witness to these encounters with the risen Lord to others?

We now enter the Octave of Easter which comprises the eight days that stretch from the first Sunday of Easter to the second Sunday of Easter. It is a way of prolonging the joy of the initial day. In a sense, every day of the Octave is like a little Sunday. Consider attending one or more daily Masses this week or spending additional time in prayer.



Divine Mercy

Next weekend, we celebrate the Feast of Divine Mercy Sunday, a feast day added to the liturgical calendar by St. John Paul II to celebrate the overwhelming mercy of Jesus Christ. Parishioners will lead the Divine Mercy Chaplet in the Chapel immediately following the 4:00pm (Saturday) & 9:00am (Sunday) Masses. All are invited to join in this powerful prayer.

Parishioners also gather to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet in the Chapel on the last Saturday of each month, following the 4:00pm Mass. This month the prayers will be recited on Saturday, April 27th. This is a regular devotional event that is always open to anyone who wishes to join in.

The Little White Books for the Easter Season are available again this year in the Gathering Space. This year the book covers passages from the Resurrection Narrative according to Matthew with suggested reflections that are an excellent resource for daily prayer. It's important to take time each day to be mindful of God's presence in our lives and the great gift of the Risen Christ. A \$2 donation for each book would be appreciated.

Just like that, the 2024 St. Jane Frances de Chantal Fish Fry season has come to a close. It was incredible to watch an amazing army of volunteers all come together to generate over 500 fish dinners every week. On behalf of Fr. WAY TO GO, FAMILY OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD VOLUNTEERS!

Last year, Our Lady of Czestochowa, Ss. Cyril & Methodius, St. Jane Frances de Chantal, and St. Rene Goupil, formed a **Walking with Moms in Need (WWMIN)** ministry to help women and families in challenging pregnancy and parenting situations. Gianna House is a residential home in Eastpointe that provides support to young, pregnant women and mothers who are at-risk or who lack safe housing. Through its education, counseling, and life skills programs, Gianna House helps women transition to independence.

In December 2023, WWMIN members learned that Gianna House needed volunteers to sort through two hundred boxes, bags, and containers of clean baby, child, maternity, and women's items salvaged from the water damage the building sustained in 2022. At the time, it was not possible for a person to freely walk from one end of the basement to the other. Clothing and supplies filled the entire basement.

The goal was to renovate and organize the area for its intended use as a baby store for Gianna House residents and local community members. In the store, essential items are offered at no cost. Women who register for and attend education and self-improvement classes, are acknowledged with "baby bucks", which they use to buy items from the shop. The program provides a 'hand up' instead of a 'handout,' to help build self-esteem and reward initiatives that can enrich their families and futures.

The Family of the Good Shepherd WWMIN volunteers tackled the project with gusto. A total of 20 volunteers donated their time and energy building storage shelves, sorting and folding baby clothing, cleaning, fixing, and organizing. Their goal to create a newly renovated baby store in the Gianna House basement was completed on March 16, 2024.
