## World Day of Prayer for Vocations: You are a priest forever in the line of Melchizedek

A few years ago, I received a book entitled *Disciples Together on the Road, Words of Pope Francis for Priests*, published in 2016 by Libreria Editrice Vaticana. The book is a series of talks that Pope Francis gave to priests bishops and laity throughout his travels.

In his very down to earth style, Pope Francis explores the joys and challenges of priesthood. I have found the book to be very affirming of the role of priests in today's society and the world. I use it often as spiritual reading and my prayer life.

Today, the Catholic Church celebrates Priesthood Sunday, a day set aside to affirm the role of priests as central to the life of the church. As I reflect upon my years as a priest, I can honestly say that there have been more joyful experiences in my ministry as priest. However, like any vocation or profession we do experience the challenges that life does present to us from time to time.

As we have seen over the course of a few years, the number of priests are declining yet the needs of the people are still being met. Children are being baptized, the dead are being buried, the sick are being anointed, men and women are being married, and people have choices as to what Mass they wish to attend on any given weekend. There is no shortage of priests because as I said, peoples spiritual needs are still being met.

God continues to call and the care of the Church is in God's hands. We are servants of God and we are called to be of service to our brothers and sisters and to the church. The one overall challenge that I have experienced throughout my priesthood is getting people to share their gifts and their talents with the greater Church. We all have something give and to share with the community of believers.

In a homily I gave a few weeks ago, I mentioned that we are all equal in the eyes of God, no one is greater than anyone else. Certainly, we might have different responsibilities, different vocations, different titles or rank. However, at the end of the day we are seen as equals in the eyes of God. The challenge that is presented to us is: how do I use my position, title, or rank to build up the Body of Christ which is the Church and the community I am a part of?

As we call to mind this Priesthood Sunday, may we give praise to God for all priests who have and continue to serve the Catholic Church throughout the world. May we remember them daily in our prayers, asking God to sustain them in their ministry.

May God empower us to hear His voice and respond to His call in service to the Church. By virtue of our Baptism everyone in the church is called to holiness and service.

The Fourth Sunday of Easter is traditionally referred to as Good Shepherd Sunday. Today, let us listen for and hear the Shepherd's voice and know that he is our God.

Today is also World Day of Prayer for Vocations. The purpose of the World Day of Prayer for Vocations is to publicly celebrate vocations to ordained ministry and religious life in all its forms. Please pray today for all our priests (and especially for Fr. Tony) and for an increase of vocations to ordained ministry and religious life everywhere.

We also enter the month of May this week, traditionally dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. The month of May is part of our yearly celebration of the 50 days of the Easter season, a time to celebrate the Resurrection of Our Lord and await the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. Mary is especially remembered during this season as she experienced extraordinary joy in her son Jesus' victory over death; Mary was also present with the apostles in the upper room, prayerfully awaiting the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.

During this month, it is good to spend more time in contemplation of Mary's role as a model of faith, as a disciple of Jesus, and as an intercessor for us. In 1965, Pope Paul VI wrote a short encyclical on the month of May. He wrote that May is an occasion for a "moving tribute of faith and love which Catholics in every part of the world pay to the Queen of Heaven. During this month Christians, both in church and in the privacy of the home, offer up to Mary from their hearts an especially fervent and loving homage of prayer and veneration. In this month, too, the benefits of God's mercy come down to us from her throne in greater abundance."

At St. Jane Frances, we will celebrate the crowning of Mary just before the 7:00pm Mass on Tuesday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> at 6:45pm. This is a beautiful custom that expresses our love for the Mother of God as our Queen. There is also a group that prays the Rosary each Tuesday at 6:00pm in the main Worship Space. You are always welcome to join in.

In honoring Mary, we are ultimately praising God for the grace He bestowed on her. May the Blessed Virgin Mary intercede for us and draw us closer to Christ her Son!
