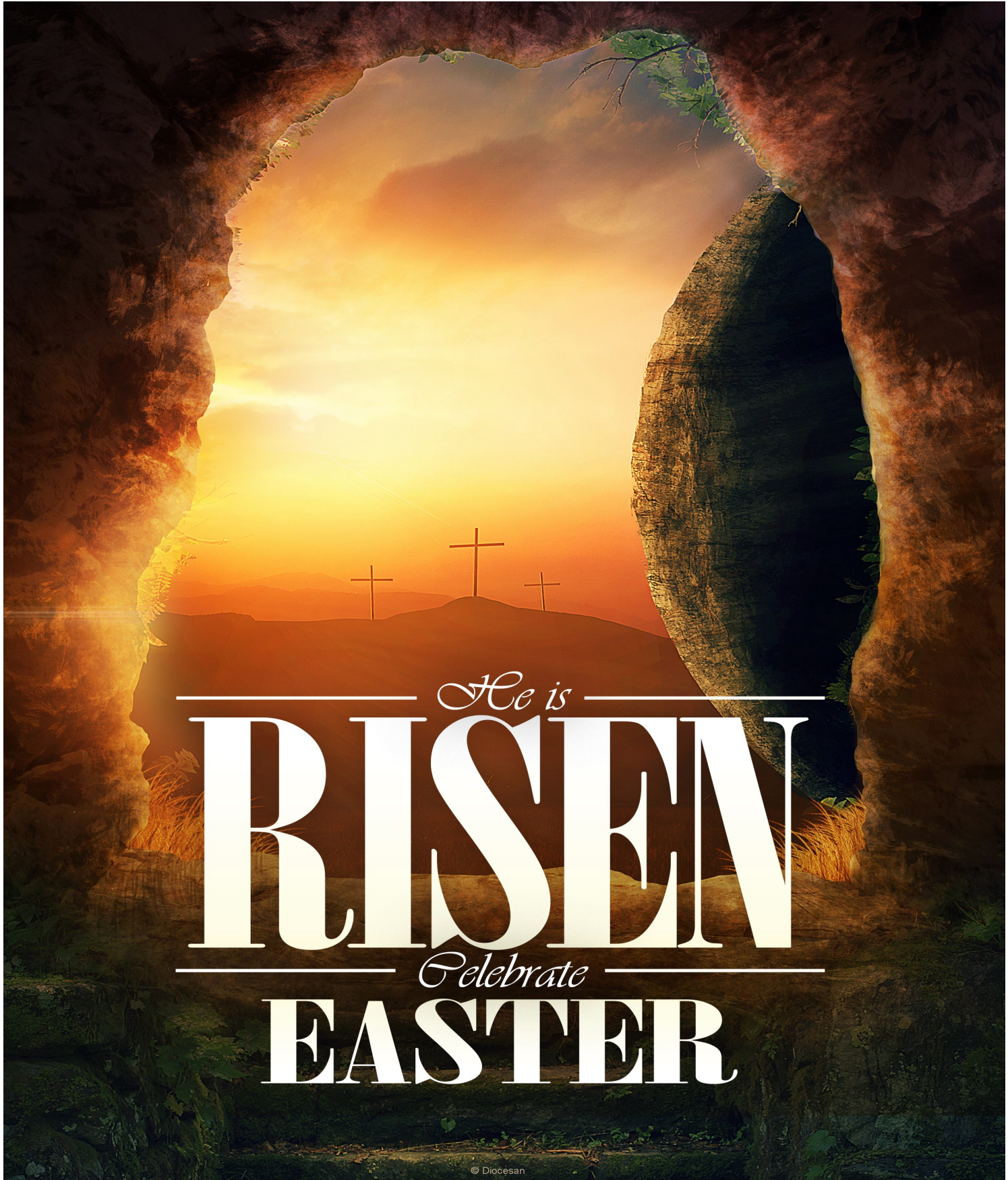

Easter

The priest of the parish read the Gospel for the Easter Mass. He kissed the Book of the Gospels and proceeded to descend the steps of the altar. He cleared his throat and said to the congregation. I am going to give you the shortest homily you ever heard as we celebrate the Great Feast of Easter.

He said: "either, you believe that Christ has Risen from the tomb or you don't. The choice is yours". And with that said he continued with the Mass.

Indeed Christ has risen from the tomb, He told his disciples He would. Sometimes the easiest choices are the most challenging. For forty days of Lent we have been preparing to celebrate this day. We are like Peter and John who, after being told by the women the tomb was empty, went to the tomb, peered in and saw for them that indeed the tomb was empty. They saw and believed.

As we go about our work and leisure, may we take the time to see the many ways in which God reveals the Risen Christ to us. Happy Easter, Wesolego Alleluja, Pasque Felice, Feliz Pascua.

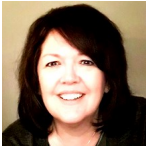

Rejoice! This is the day that the Lord has made. God’s love and mercy have been poured out for all and to all. By his sacrifice on the cross, Jesus has conquered

sin and defeated death. No longer do sin and death have power over us. A new day dawns, for new life has dawned for all of us: a life in God’s tender loving care that survives sin and overcomes death. Jesus has shown us the way to the Father. The crosses we carry—our fears and our struggles, our sorrows and our traumas—are united with the cross of our Lord, which did not end in pain and death but with joy and life. May the promise of the Resurrection fill us with hope, enliven our lives, and lead us to life eternal. Alleluia!

We now enter the Octave of Easter which comprises the eight days that stretch from the first Sunday of Easter to the Second Sunday of Easter. It is a way of prolonging the joy of the initial day. In a sense, every day of the Octave is like a little Sunday. Consider attending one or more daily Masses this week or spending additional time in prayer.

Next week, Sunday, April 16th, we celebrate the Feast of Divine Mercy, a feast day added to the liturgical calendar by St. John Paul II to celebrate the overwhelming mercy of Jesus Christ. Parishioners will lead the Divine Mercy Chaplet in the Chapel that day immediately following the 9:00am Mass. All are invited to join in this powerful prayer.

Parishioners also gather to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet in the Chapel on the last Saturday of each month, following the 4:00pm Mass. This month the prayers will be recited on Saturday, April 29th. This is a regular devotional event that is always open to anyone who wishes to join in.

The Little White Books for the Easter Season are available again this year in the Gathering Space. This year the book covers passages from the Resurrection Narratives according to Luke with suggested reflections that are an excellent resource for daily prayer. It’s important to take time each day to be mindful of God’s presence in our lives and the great gift of the Risen Christ. A \$1 donation for each book would be appreciated.

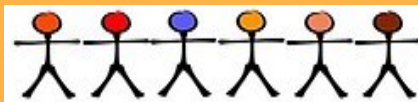

We are so grateful for the generosity of the St. Jane Frances Parishioners for your donations to help us continue this important ministry.

The Denis Connection started with an idea I had after my brother passed away. His name was Dennis, and I believe that he died of loneliness. It made me realize that since I was the only person who spent time with him, one person is not enough. People need people. I named the ministry after my brother, and it stands for "Delivering Encouragement, Nurturing & Increasing Socialization." We started as a visiting ministry but also provide transportation to appointments and errands. We would like to get this ministry up and running again but we need your help.
