As of July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 the four parishes, namely Our Lady of Czestochowa, Sts. Cyril and Methodius, St. Rene Goupil and St. Jane Frances de Chantal will officially become a Family of Parishes. Let me state from the outset that nothing will change in the daily operations of our individual parishes.

The priests of our families have had several meetings to define and write a covenant that will aid us in sharing of resources. For example, each Advent and Lent, Sts. Cyril and Methodius hosts a reconciliation day in which the priests of the families of parishes come together for one day to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation with the people of our four parishes. This event allows a great number of people to celebrate the Sacrament and it is less taxing on the priests.

With the declining number of priests, the needs of the people are still being met; people are still being married and buried, children are still being baptized and Masses are being celebrated at various times throughout the week and weekend.

Families of Parishes is also a time for the people of God to come forward to offer their gifts and talents in service to the church. There is no such thing as too many volunteers. We are slowly coming out of the pandemic, people are returning to church. We are experiencing the new normal, yet we are in need of new volunteers in every ministry at St. Jane Frances de Chantal. We all have gifts and talents and we all can do our part to “build up the body of Christ.”

In the Easter season as we draw ever closer to the great Feast of Pentecost, may we be open in the prompting of the Spirit. The Spirit will endow us with the gifts of service and ministry within the Church. As Cardinal John Francis Dearden often said, “the more difficult the task, the more the Spirit will be given.”

I believe that Families of Parishes is the Spirit’s response to this present time in the Church. It is also a time for all of us to “think outside the box” in regards to the Church and her mission. As I mentioned on Holy Thursday, the Church has changed in the thirty-five years since I was ordained a priest and in will continue to change. It is not the same church that I was ordained into in 1986. However, what has not changed throughout the church’s history is that the Eucharist is the “summit and source of who we are, it is the spiritual food that sustains us and strengthens us for the journey”.

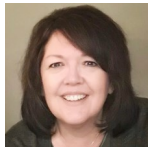

May is the month that we particularly remember the Blessed Virgin Mary. “As the Mother of God, the Virgin Mary has a unique position among the saints, indeed, among all creatures. She is exalted, yet still one of us.

Mary embraces God's will and freely chooses to cooperate with God's grace, thereby fulfilling a crucial role in God's plan of salvation. Throughout the centuries, the Church has turned to the Blessed Virgin in order to come closer to Christ. Many forms of piety toward the Mother of God developed that help bring us closer to her Son. In these devotions to Mary, while the Mother is honored, the Son, through whom all things have their being and in whom it has pleased the Father that all fullness should dwell, is rightly known, loved and glorified and . . . all His commands are observed. The Church honors her as the Mother of God, looks to her as a model of perfect discipleship, and asks for her prayers to God on our behalf” (USCCB)

We have a beautiful statue of Mary that, since the beginning of the pandemic, has stood just inside the worship space entrance doors. We know that not only our parish community but the larger community that surrounds our parish has a devotion to our Blessed Mother and often finds comfort in this image. We would like to add a statue of Mary to our outdoor garden, providing greater access to those who wish to pray with Mary, and move the indoor statue back to its former place inside the gathering space.

We would like to manage the cost of purchasing a statue of Mary by asking you, the parishioners, to donate to the Mary Statue fund. This would be a nice way to remember a loved one who was particularly devoted to Mary or as a way to express your dedication to our Blessed Mother. We have been searching for a large concrete statue that can withstand the winter season but, due to material and transportation shortages, have not yet found one that is available and reasonably priced. I will keep you updated in this column as soon as we are successful in locating the right statue.

**TODAY'S GOSPEL FOR KIDS**

**Sixth Sunday of Easter**  
**John 14:23-29**

**GOSPEL EXPLANATION FOR KIDS**

How many of you have ever lost something? I know I have! At times like that, I really wish I had a helper to help me find what I have lost. It's hard to remember things sometimes and hard to find things we have lost. Right? In today's Gospel, God knew that sometimes it was hard to remember things, even His precious words. So what did God do? He promised us that the Holy Spirit would help us to remember the things of God and help us to also remember God's word.

**ACTIVITY**

Get a large clear plastic bag, maybe a gallon size Ziplock. Go around the house and put as many things in it as you can fit, things like a shoelace, pen, pencil, staples, rubber band, coins, paper clip, cell phone, TV remote, spoon, fork, band aid, Q-tip, glue stick, hair tie, comb, etc. Put the bag on your table and cover it with a towel. Gather family members together around the table. Give them each a piece of paper and a pencil. Tell them you are going to lift up the towel for 20 seconds. After 20 seconds, put the towel back over the bag. See who can remember the most items that were in the bag and write them down on their paper. Remind them that God sent the Holy Spirit to help us remember things about God and to remember God's word.
