Catechetical Sunday

With school well underway, we also begin Faith Formation at St. Jane Frances de Chantal. Mr. Michael Novak and the catechists are gearing up for an exciting year of Faith Formation. The Catholic Church will celebrate Catechetical Sunday on September 17th. Next Sunday we will bless the catechists and the students as they embark on a year of discovering new aspects of the faith and how to implement them into their daily life.

The catechists are a great group of people who meet every month with the children, impart the faith of the Catholic Church, and share their own stories and journey of faith. However, the catechists rely on the parents of our children to share their faith and journey of faith with their children. The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us that parents are the first teachers of the faith. Children learn by what their parent's model for them. As I mentioned in my homily two weeks ago, we learn by the examples people set for us. May we model our faith for our children and for all those we come in contact with. In his book titled *Spiritual Writings*, Leo Tolstoy said "a Christian knows the truth only in the sense that he or she shows it to others." As we begin the faith formation year let us share our stories of our own faith journey and in the process build up the Body of Christ.

The Catechism also reminds us that the faith community as a whole must also model and give good example by word and deed what it means to be a follower and disciple of the Lord.

The theme of this year's Catechetical Sunday is Come to me all you who labor and are burdened (Mt 11:28). This theme reminds us that we are all called to give witness to our faith in Jesus Christ. We begin this Faith Formation year invoking God to bless the children and their families, our catechists and faith community with a spirit of wonderment and awe about their faith. May we be open to the prompting of the Holy Spirit in our lives and the lives of the community of St. Jane Frances de Chantal.

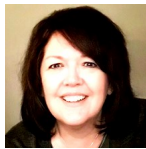

Are you Interested in learning more about the Bible in a casual, sharing atmosphere? Join our Bible Study group!

We are ready to return to Bible Study after the summer break. Each Bible Study session lasts six weeks, meeting each of those weeks on Tuesday mornings from 10:00am-11:30am. For our next session, we will return to the Book of Genesis, verses 25-33, Jacob's Blessing. Jacob's story shows us how God's love prevails through the conflicts and failures of a troubled family. In Genesis 25-33: Jacob's Blessing, authors Kevin and Louise Perrotta, guide readers through Jacob's story, showing how this ancient biblical account still speaks volumes to us today."

The series we use is very understandable and organized to provide both fascinating insight to the Scriptures as well as a lot of opportunities to discuss and share. Our next session will begin September 19th and run through October 24th.

The guide includes the Scripture passages, insights from Church fathers and saints, questions for discussion and reflection, and prayer suggestions. It doesn't matter if you have never studied the Bible before or if you are experienced with Bible study, all are welcome!

Reading and reflecting on Scripture provides a wonderful way to get to know God and enter into deeper relationship with him. I look forward to sharing Scripture with others, growing in understanding God's word, while sharing our different viewpoints!

If you are ready to join in, please RSVP by calling the office or sending me an email. Please also plan to bring a copy of the book which is available for \$7.95 on Amazon; simply search for the title: Jacob's Blessing (Six Weeks with the Bible).

Do you love to read and are interested in books that spark spiritual discussion? Join our Book Club!

The Book Club meets on the second and fourth Thursday of each month, from 10:30am – 12:00pm in the lower level of the parish offices. Each book that our group has read has brought something different to our continued conversion, forming us ever closer in relationship to God and each other. Our next book is *Come Forth* by Fr. James Martin. The publisher's description: "In this wise and compassionate book, New York Times bestselling author Father James Martin, SJ, explores the story of Jesus's greatest miracle—the raising of Lazarus from the dead—and what Jesus means when he calls each of us to 'come forth.' Meditatively and carefully, Father Martin leads us verse by verse, offering profound reflections on Jesus's lessons on love, family, sadness, frustration, fear, anger, freedom, and joy.

Come Forth combines compelling analysis of the biblical text, insights about the historical setting of the story, spiritual lessons for today's readers, meditations on Lazarus in art and the larger culture, as well as stories from Martin's travels through the Holy Land. As he explores these strands in depth, Martin helps us let go of the limiting beliefs that prevent us from experiencing God's presence in our lives. We need only to open ourselves to the transformative story of Lazarus and trust that God can use it to free us to experience, like Lazarus, new life."

Our first meeting of the Book Club is September 14th. Please plan to bring a copy of the book, it is available for purchase at most bookstores, including Amazon. All are welcome, please just give me a call or an email to let me know to expect you and add you to my list. Once you are on the list, I will provide the reading plan via email.

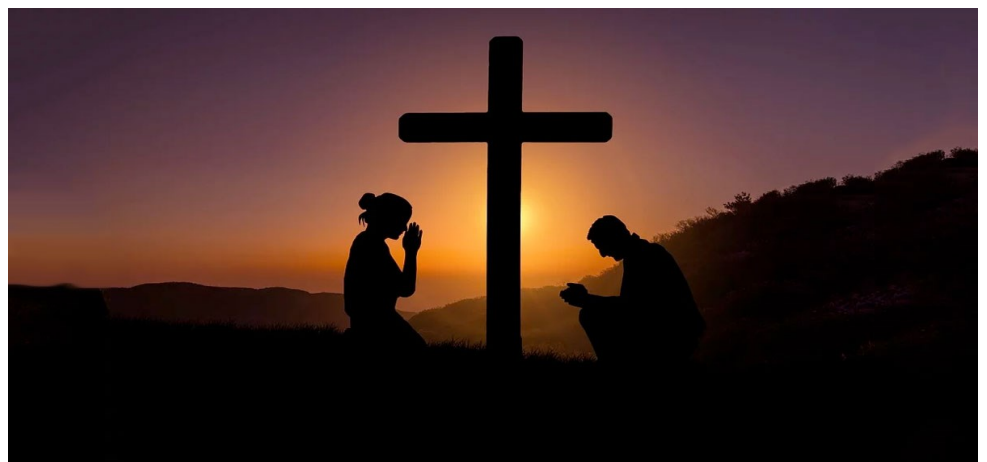
